1. On 15 October 1952, surveying at Tutow airfield by the Bauunion Brandenburg was nearing completion. Construction work at the field was given the official designation W-103. Construction work at the field was to be executed by the Bauunion Nordost. In exchange, the Bauunion Brandenburg was contracted for the improvement of Parchim airfield, which was given the official designation W-104. 25X1

2. On 26 October, [redacted] part of the construction workers at Brand airfield had signed contracts for work at Tutow airfield. Some carriers from Luebbenau, who had signed contracts for operations on Ruegen Island were to be employed for work at Tutow airfield.
