2.	YD-242352, near P'yongyang, to assist in the training of North Korean army units. About 50 civilian houses in the area were used as billets for the 50X1-HUM advisers. A Chinese Communist battalion guarded the area. 80 North Korean army artillery officers began a 2-week 50X1-HUM course on the operation of 120-mm. (sic) and 35-mm. (sic) anti-aircraft guns under the direction of these Soviet and Hungarian officers. 50X1-HUM one of the Soviets was supervising the construction of 2 x 120-mm. and 2 x 35-mm. anti-aircraft gun positions at YD-355256.	
3.	3. five Soviets dressed in Chinese Communist winter uniforms and 50X1-HUM two interpreters arrived at Tongkochi (approximately YC-506652), near Obong-ni (125-59, 38-32) (YC-6069), in jeeps. The Soviets stayed at Tongkochi several days inspecting documents of the district (myon), county (gun), and provincial government people's committees. The Soviets did not leave their billet during their stay and were visited by only a few high-ranking officers.
