1. [REDACTED] a supply depot of the Volkspolizei (VP), presumably an ordnance depot, was located in the former Schoeneicherplan Plexiglas Works, formerly the Sunlight soap plant. [REDACTED]

as early as the summer of 1952, residents from Mittenwalde were employed at the installation. They had to maintain strict secrecy. A large number of trucks was assigned to this VP installation.

- 2. From 17 to 30 October, 51 carloads of beds, 3 carloads of chairs, 2 carloads of overcoats and 1 carload of machinery arrived at the installation.
- 3. Outgoing shipments leaving the installation during the same period included: 13 carloads of beds and chairs, dispatched to Eggesin for Herr Porkowski (fnu); 10 carloads of beds, dispatched to Lietzow for Herr Woithe (fnu); 3 carloads of beds, dispatched to Prennitz for the Kasernierte Volkspolizei Dienststelle (KVPD); 2 carloads of beds, dispatched to Oranienburg for the KVPD; 3 carloads of beds, dispatched to Prenzlau for the KVPD; 3 carloads of beds, dispatched to Binz for Herr Woithe; and 2 carloads of chairs, dispatched to Pasewalk for the KVPD, c/o Herr Winkler.

1. Comment. So far, the existence of two central KVP clothing and general equipment depots had been known, i.e. the depot at Prossen near Rad Schandau and another one on Marzahner Chaussee (Nagervichhof) in Berlin-Friedrichsfelde/Ost. It is proved by the data contained in paragraph 3 that the supply depot in Mittenwalde belongs to the KVP. KVP units are stationed in Eggesin, Prenzlau and Pasewalk. KVP units moved to Prennitz and Oranienburg in late October. Lietzow and Binz on Rügen Island are detrainning points for the KVPD at Prora. Herr Woithe is certainly identical with VP Major Woithe (fnu) who, in early September 1952, became deputy supply officer of the KVPD at Prora. [REDACTED]
