Sverdlovsk (56-50N, 60-38E)	Military building of one large angle-shaped five-story building with columns and a park.	Not specified.	Seat of the commanding officer of the post headquarters, Major General Chernigov (fnu). Soldiers wearing black epaulets mounting No. 315, and others wearing red-bordered epaulets mounting No. 178 R, were observed in the building.
Molotov (58-00N, 56-15E)	1. Billeting area of two wooden cantonment buildings.	Southeastern perimeter of the city, near a brickyard, north of the southeast-bound thoroughfare.	Occupied by about 100 soldiers wearing black-bordered red epaulets mounting No. 62 K.
	2. Billeting area of two wooden cantonment buildings.	South of the city, about 700 meters southwest of Plant No. 19.	Occupied by about 150 men wearing the same service color and No. 33 K.
Kirov (58-33N, 49-42E)	Barracks installation of two four-story buildings, one long secondary building, and an entrance with a gateway.	West of the city.	Occupied by an engineer unit the size of a battalion. The soldiers wore black-bordered black epaulets. Three units each numbering about 100 men were observed falling out.
