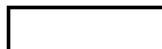
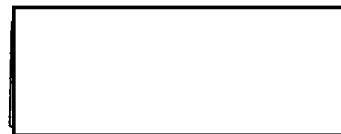

1. Paragraph 3 of referent summarizes various comments at the 19 February 1976 USIB meeting on a Department of State request for a COMEX assessment of the US intelligence benefits from [redacted] exchanges.

2. Since the USIB meeting, I have met with Department of State representatives and their original request has been modified. Instead of attempting a relatively quick overall assessment limited to the US intelligence benefits from the exchanges since 1972, COMEX will request Community analytical participation in preparing from 10-12 evaluations of net US [redacted] benefits.
