- 1. Although this estimate recognized that many French citizens were dissatisfied with the Fourth Republic, it concluded: "we do not think that there is any immediate prospect that the Republic will be overthrown. The Communist do not now have the capability, and the extreme right lacks leaders, followers and a program.

  Government as usual will probably continue".
- 2. The basic reason for this erroneous conclusion was our belief that the Armed Forces would not assist in an overthrow of the Fourth Republic.
- 3. The error in the conclusion "that government as usual will probably continue" was reflected in other judgments contained in the estimate.
