	3. Tab A shows 64 of the 176 priority targets in South China and North Vietnam on which satisfactory base line/surveillance coverage has been obtained since 1 March 1966. The base line coverage total was increased by two targets as a result of a BLUE SPRINGS mission on road construction at Wa Pu Chieh and Tsa Ti Pao in South China. The same BLUE SPRINGS mission and four BLUE TREE missions, flown in a previous reporting period, provided surveillance coverage of seven priority targets. 4. The number of times each target was satisfactorily covered is shown in Tab A as well as the dates of initial and most recent satisfactory coverage since 1 March 1966. This information is provided in order to record the progress in obtaining base line coverage and the frequency of surveillance of the priority targets in South China and North Vietnam.	5 X 1


