Culver's (D., Iowa) floor statement to be given the early part of next week. This portion is based on testimony given by the Agency before the Subcommittee on General Legislation, of which Senator Culver is Chairman. Dawson noted that all of the changes suggested by the Agency were accepted.

Dawson mentioned that the Senate Armed Services Committee, in its review of the Defense Authorization bill, is deferring completely to the Senate Select Committee on Intelligence as concerns the Agency's budget. The Senate Armed Services Committee, however, is exercising oversight review of "intelligence related activities" in the Defense Authorization bill.
