20. [redacted] LIAISON Mrs. Morley Howle, in the district office of Representative William Whitehurst (R., Va.), called regarding a "professed superspy." She said a constituent of Mr. Whitehurst's, who formerly worked for the OSS and is now 72 years of Age and destitute, is trying to establish a credibility service under Civil Service Retirement for a period of service prior to his OSS employment when he said he was working "under orders of the White House." The constituent, [redacted] (Social Security Number [redacted]) has suffered a slight stroke which has left him with some impairment of his facilities. Mrs. Howle mentioned that [redacted] a former Agency employee, had reportedly checked on Coleman's service and had verified it (although it was not clear whether she was referring to OSS service or prior service). I told her we would check into this and call her back.
