18. (Unclassified - HB) LEGISLATION I called Jim Jura, OMB, concerning the request for comments on H. R. 6249, the "Uniform Federal Research and Development Utilization Act of 1977." He extended OMB's deadline for response until 27 July 1977.

19. (Unclassified - HB) LEGISLATION Mr. Sokowski, of the National War College, called to inquire as to the final vote on the House Select Committee on Intelligence. He was so advised.

20. (Confidential - DFM) LIAISON Mike Epstein, Senate Select Committee on Intelligence staff, called in reference to the Director's letter of 16 July [redacted]

[redacted] to be made available for the Senate Select Committee on Intelligence review. Epstein wanted to know when he could begin his review. He also raised a question about directions the Department of State had given the Agency in requesting that CIA prepare a memorandum for the Department of Justice summarizing our knowledge of one aspect of [redacted] matter. The Department of State request resulted in a memorandum in 1971 to the Bureau on Radio Free Asia but the memorandum did not include all our knowledge on this subject. In attempting to determine why, Epstein thought perhaps directions we received from the Department of State might have been incomplete.

21. (Unclassified - DFM) LIAISON Called Bill Miller, Staff Director, Senate Select Committee on Intelligence, regarding a meeting scheduled for Admiral Stansfield Turner with Senators Daniel K. Inouye (D., Hawaii), Barry Goldwater (R., Ariz.) and Robert Morgan (D., N. C.), Senate Select Committee on Intelligence, regarding the [redacted] Miller 25X1 said this had been discussed at his meeting with the Director and George Cary, Legislative Counsel, earlier today and that the three Senators would have to meet alone before seeing Admiral Turner. I said Admiral Turner was free either 4:30 p.m. 27 July or 5:00 p.m. 28 July. Miller said he would let me know when the Senators could meet with the Director.
