CIA practice has been to retain initial document receipts for a period of two years and, in most cases, all such receipts for the life of the document. Should a document be downgraded, decompartmented or destroyed, record of such action will still be retained for a five year period. This is a CIA general record schedule requirement.

The impression that CIA may destroy all receipts within six months may stem from a provision in DCID 1/19 which states a "record of the initial receipt and internal distribution of all SCI received, by any means, for a minimum of six months". However, the ame documents demands that individual receipts covering individual SCI items transferred must be retained for a minimum of two years.
