MONTHLY ACTIVITIES REPORT
AUGUST 1978

1. [] A comprehensive set of guidelines for Community use in adjudicating the results of DCID 1/14 investigations for access to compartmented information was completed and circulated for comment. The guidelines cover such subjects as foreign relatives and associates, sexual and other misconduct, untruthfulness and character deficiencies, financial irresponsibility, alcohol and drug abuse, psychological disturbances, criminal conduct, and loyalty. Upon appropriate approval, the guidelines will be issued as an adjunct to DCID 1/14.

2. [] A Community-wide statistical study of the utility and significance of the various elements of DCID 1/14 personnel security investigations will begin shortly. A computer program has been developed to record and process data resulting from this effort. The results of the study will show what elements of an investigation are most productive of pertinent information, thereby providing the basis for changes in Community investigative procedures.



4. [] The Committee staff has been contributing to review and identification of technical security requirements for []

25X1 5. [] A Committee working group is exploring arrangements for establishing and maintaining a possible central Community registry of denials of proposed access to compartmented information. This registry would help in ensuring greater uniformity in Community access determinations.

25X1 6. [] A review of Community security guidance was begun to identify changes which are either necessary or desirable in the light of new national policy on classification and control of information as set forth in Executive Order 12065 and its implementing directive.

25X1 7. [] The Committee staff has continued to provide inputs to the study of satellite reconnaissance security policy alternatives being conducted under the aegis of the Space Policy Review Committee. The study addresses possible consequences of alternatives bearing on proposed declassification of the "fact of" an intelligence satellite capability.
