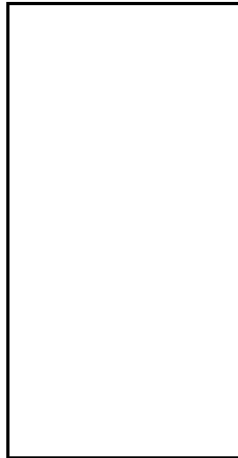


IAS STAFF MEETING MINUTES

1. Mr. Allen presented [redacted] with a certificate and a monetary token of the Agency's appreciation for his suggestion. e. Preliminary assessment will be done on Tuesday, 31 October. The DDI requested selective highlights via OAK cable on Sunday.

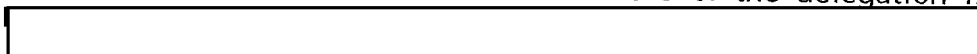
