

CABO BOJADOR AIRFIELD, WESTERN SAHARA

1. (S/D) SIGNIFICANCE: MOROCCAN ARMOR UNIT IN THE WESTERN SAHARA.

2. (S/D) REMARKS: AT LEAST ONE PROBABLE M-48 TANK COMPANY AND ONE MECHANIZED INFANTRY BATTALION HAVE DEPLOYED NEAR THE SOUTHEAST ZONE OF THE MOROCCAN DEFENSIVE AREA (ABOUT 3 NM NORTH OF THE DEFENSIVE BERM) AT CABO BOJADOR AIRFIELD [Redacted] THE TANK UNIT JOINS A MECHANIZED INFANTRY REGIMENT WHICH WAS SEEN MOVING TOWARD THE AIRFIELD IN CONVOY YESTERDAY. THE CONVOY IS NOT PRESENT TODAY. THE MECHANIZED INFANTRY BATTALION WHICH WAS DEPLOYED 6.5 NM SOUTHEAST OF THE AIRFIELD AT 26-02-51N 014-26-26W [Redacted]

THE ARMORED UNIT CONSISTS OF FIVE PROBABLE M-48 TANKS, THREE M-113 ARMORED PERSONNEL CARRIERS (APC), ONE M-548 LIGHT RECOVERY VEHICLE, AND FOUR PROBABLE UTILITY VEHICLES DEFENSIVELY DEPLOYED AT 26-05-42N 014-28-48W. NEARBY, FIVE PROBABLE M-48 TANKS AND ONE M-113 APC ON HEAVY LIFT TRANSPORTERS APPEAR TO BE IN THE PROCESS OF UNLOADING. FOUR ADDITIONAL M-113 APC AND AT LEAST 41 SIX-TON CARGO TRUCKS ARE PRESENT. ONE MECHANIZED INFANTRY BATTALION IS IN A DEFENSIVE POSTURE IMMEDIATELY NORTH OF THE TANKS.

CABO BOJADOR, ON THE ATLANTIC COAST, IS 125 NM SOUTH OF THE MOROCCO-WESTERN SAHARA BORDER. THE MOROCCAN DEFENSIVE AREA/BERM EXTENDS 225 NM TO THE NORTHEAST TO TAN TAN AIRFIELD
