- 1. On 11 February a new Asuncion television station began transmitting in color with 30 watts on Channel 13. It broadcasts daily from 1500-0300 GMT.
- Intensive cruising was conducted to find a morning Brazilian newscast to replace Porto Alegre Radio Gaucha in Portuguese at 1545 GMT, which was lost to interference from a local radio station. Four newscasts were found and are now being evaluated.
- Other cruising observations during the month included:
- a. Asuncion Domestic Service in Spanish was observed on a new frequency of 11915 KHZ.
