Subject: Aviation Technical School near Warsaw



1. In January 1944, the aviation technical school at Bodziszewo near Warsaw possessed the following aircraft which were used for training purposes:
- One aircraft, type P-3 (Potlikov), equipped with two 30mm guns and two Berizia MG's; power output 1410 HP, engine type WK-105 P.F., maximum speed 480 km. per hour.
 - Three assault aircraft IL-2, equipped with one 30mm gun and two Berizia MG's; the engine is AM-38-F, output 1700 HP, speed 300 km. per hour.
 - Three Jak-9 fighters and one Jak-5 fighter. The latter is equipped with engine IK-105-FV, maximum speed 300 km. per hour, and is armed with a 30mm gun and one Sakas machine gun whose caliber is 7.62mm (?).
 - One UT-4 pursuit plane with WK-105-FV engine, maximum speed 300 km. per hour. Its armament consists of two Berlin machine guns and one Sakas machine gun.
 - Two reconnaissance Po-2 biplanes ("Kukuramiks"), maximum speed 150 km per hour. It is armed with one Sakas machine gun.

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
