Propaganda for recruiting of International Brigades in Albania is increasing. The "Central Military Committee for Anti-Pascist Action in Payor of Democratic Spain and Greece" is responsible for forming the International Brigades. Propaganda is directed by the propaganda section of NASH (Communist organization of the Albanian Youth Movement). NASH is assisted by the similar Yugoslav organization US40J and by the Greek organization BPON. NASH is directed by Major General Nako Spiru, Minister of National Economy. His assistants are Brana Perovic, a Yugoslav, and Nicholas Akritidis, a Greek.

the Central Military Committee, the president of which is Lt. Colonel Ramadan Xhangolli, has five fully equipped battalions at its disposal. These are as follows:

2 and 3 above are names of Albanian partisans who were killed in the resistance. Kosova is the name of an Albanian female detachment of the Albanian guerrillas.

4. Training of all the above battalions is directed by Colonel Ivanov of the Soviet Army, who lives in Tirana.

Comment: It is not known whether this Ivanov is the same as the head of the present Soviet Military Mission in Tirana.)
