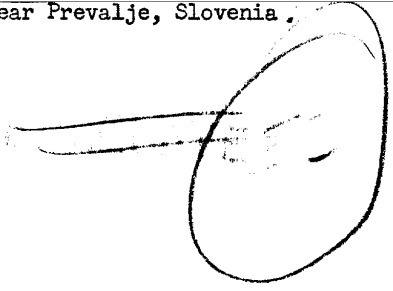

1. The Tovarna Lesovine in Lepenke (Pulp and Cardboard Plant) is in Zagrada, south of Prevalje on the south bank of the Meza River, between the river dam and the road leading to Dobja Vas. The entire site is surrounded by a fence. It was built before the last war but in 1943 was stripped and destroyed by Tito partisans. After the German armistice in 1945 it was reconstructed, enlarged and improved. The plant is now under the jurisdiction of the Slovene Ministry of Light Industry and is directed and controlled by the State Timber Cooperative in Maribor. It produces cardboard and pulp (cellulose) with a capacity of 1½ carloads per week. Lumber and raw materials are received through the State Timber Cooperative in Maribor and drawn from unspecified domestic resources.


All machinery in the plant is electrically driven. Current is supplied by the Valenje Slovene State power plant.

The mill actually began producing in 1927. It now has eighty employees and operates in two eight-hour shifts.

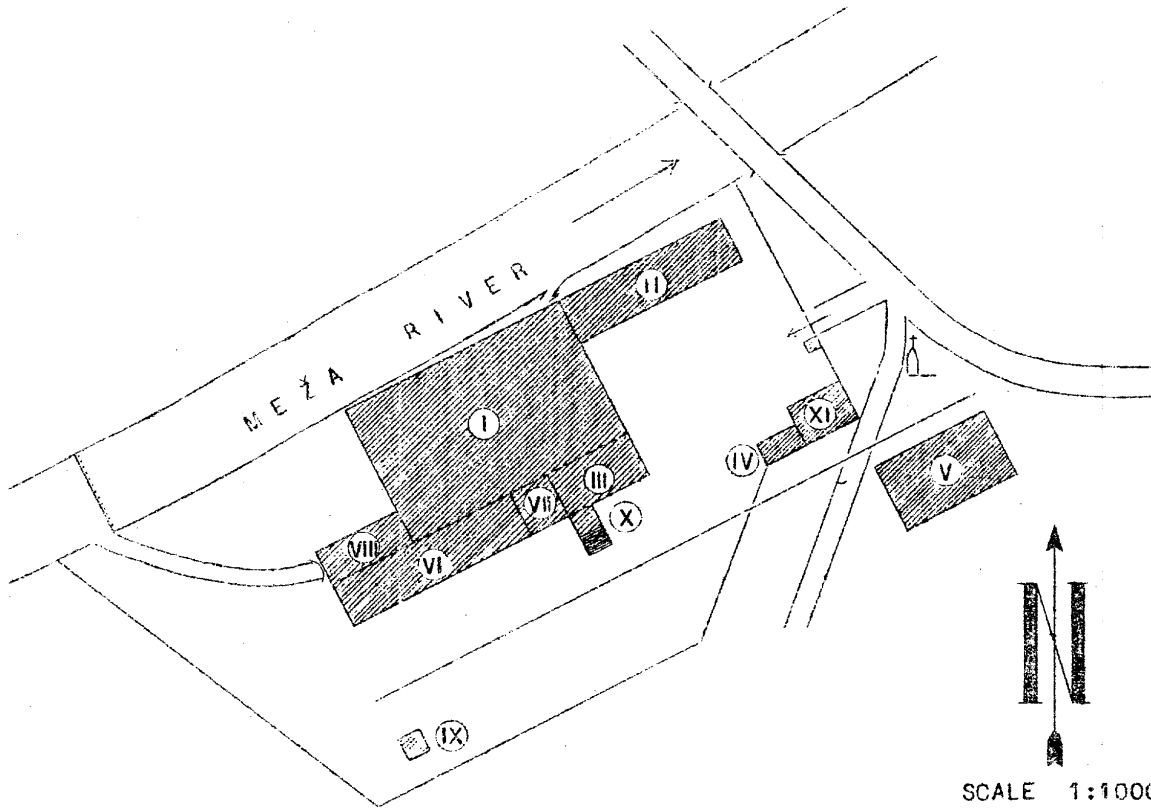
- IV Size 7½ x 4 x 6 m., contains machine repair shop.

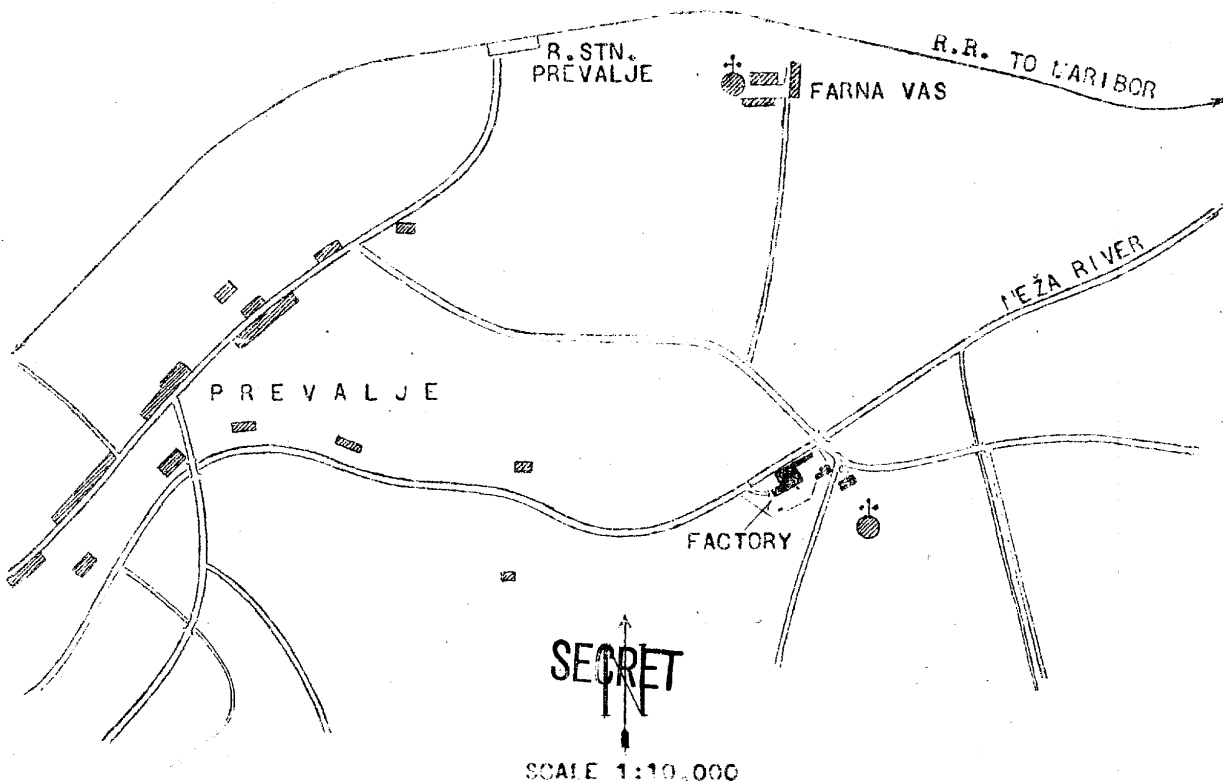
