Dr. Vavro Srobar, Minister of Unification of Laws, was asked by the Czechoslovak Government to invite Josko David, former Chairman of the Czechoslovak Parliament, and 25X1A Frana Zeminova, a member of the National Socialist Party, to submit suggestions for a new cabinet which would be acceptable to the western powers.* Zeminova is understood to have declined the invitation, while David's decision had been unannounced up to 20 May 1949. It is further reported that Dr. Josef Kalfus.
