Part I

SOVIET ARMY FORCES IN EUROPE

1. General Situation in the Soviet-Occupied Territories of Europe

Reports received from all Soviet-occupied territories of Europe indicate no essential change in the previous OB picture. The situation may be characterized as intensified training and maneuvers of various kinds. The reports supplied from 10 July to 10 August 1949 contain no clues which would indicate an essential increase in the Soviet occupation troops.

2. Germanya. General

(1) On the whole, the previous OB picture of the Soviet troops in Germany was confirmed by the reports received from 10 July to 10 August 1949. No essential changes occurred in the organization, strength and disposition of the troops of the Occupation Forces Germany (OFG).

All large units (divisions) and command elements were confirmed until July 1949 by the systematic observation of military posts, military traffic [redacted] (most of them until late in July).

b. Strength, Organization and Disposition of the Soviet Occupation Troops in Germany

(1) Strength

(a) The number of tank, mechanized and rifle divisions did not increase. One, or possibly two, AAA divisions (Cadre?) have been activated in the area of the Third and Fourth Gds Mecz Army (Cadre) since the spring of 1949, in addition to numerous training units.

(b) The number of personnel of the Soviet occupation troops is greater than in the summer of 1948, mainly due to the arrival of a large number of recruits who, were assigned to the cadre armies during the spring and summer of 1949.

(c) It is believed that the materiel available to the occupation troops has not greatly increased since the spring of 1949. The replenishment of weapons and equipment (particularly motor vehicles) which has been observed since the winter months of 1948/1949 may not have been completed (see paragraph 2e).

(d) The combat value of the Soviet occupation troops is believed to be high. This holds true even for the summer months of 1949. The arrival of recruits in the spring of 1949 has increased the strength of the units (including the cadre units) at least until October 1949, when older personnel will be due for discharge (see par. 2d). The disadvantage of having a large number of the [redacted] (recruits) still receiving basic training is partially counterbalanced by the older personnel of the discharge class of 1925 (?) being only gradually and at staggered intervals returned to the SO. The combat value of the Soviet occupation troops in Germany will reach its 1949 peak in the fall of the year (September/October). This peak can be maintained into the winter if the regular dismissals are suspended.

(2) Organization

(a) The general organization of the Soviet Occupation Forces in Germany did not change (i.e., six armies, including two cadre armies).

(b) One AAA division (Cadre) is assumed to have been newly assigned to each of the mechanized armies (cadre). 50X1-HUM

(c) The organization of the IV Army Corps has not yet been completely clarified. 50X1-HUM

(3) Disposition

(a) The general disposition of the Soviet Occupation Forces in Germany is known (see Annex 1). Only the area of BERLIN-BERNAU-ORANIENBURG-RATHENOW-BRANDENBURG-POTSDAM has to be investigated more closely.

(b) Intelligence activities in the area of PRENZLAU-PASSWALK have been intensified during recent weeks. The assumption that the Soviets are, or have been activating a new division in this area (4th Div of the Second Gds Mecz Army?) has not been confirmed by the reports received.

PASSWALK is occupied mainly by units of the 9th Gds Tank Div and PRENZLAU by units of the Fourth Gds Mecz Army (Cadre) (25th Tank Div (Cadre)). The PRENZLAU troops participated in maneuvers in the area of TEMPLIN in June 1949, where only units of the Fourth Gds Mecz Army (Cadre) were observed. It is possible, according to these observations, that the PRENZLAU area is assigned to the Fourth Gds Mecz Army (Cadre) and the PASSWALK area to the Second Gds Mecz Army (Cadre). The PRENZLAU area seems to be occupied mainly by training units. Further efforts are being made to clarify the situation in the PRENZLAU-PASSWALK area.

(c) Since the transfer of the 7th Gds Tank Div (Cadre), effected in February/March 1949, the situation in the KOTHEN-ROSSLAU-ZERBST area has not been sufficiently clear. Reports received in the past weeks made it possible to identify two regiments of the 7th Gds Tank Div (Cadre) as being located in KOTHEN and ZERBST.

c. Training and Maneuvers**(1) General**

(a) The training activities of the Soviet units in Germany have been concentrated at the troop training grounds since March 1949. Units at the training grounds were rotated according to the purpose of the maneuvers and the quartering facilities at the various training grounds. In most cases, the troops arrived and left by rail.

(b) It was repeatedly reported [redacted]

[redacted] that the recruits were trained in the vicinity of their stations, while the field units were transferred to the training grounds for several months. Such observations were still made in June 1949. It is assumed from experience, however, that the bulk of these recruit units will also participate in combined-arms maneuvers in the summer of 1949, which will last until September/October, as in 1948. This training will be conducted first at the known troop training grounds. 50X1-HUM

(c) Training activity increased considerably this summer as compared to the summer of 1948. This is mainly due to the fact that only few units of the cadre divisions participated in last year maneuvers. This observation confirms, to some extent, various reports according to which the strength of both cadre armies is considerably greater this year than last (see paragraph 2 b(1)(d)).

(2) Training Areas

The work of the Ob Section of this project was concentrated during recent weeks on the Soviet training areas. Annexes 3 and 4 give a survey of the most important troop training grounds used by the Soviet Occupation Troops since 1947. The training grounds are identified as:

(a) Troop Training Grounds (former regular German troop training grounds);

(b) Training areas (Soviet training fields, part of which may already have the status of regular troop training grounds);

(c) Garrison Training Areas. A detailed study of the troop training grounds, including size, target ranges, quartering facilities, etc. had to be postponed because of shortage of personnel. This work could be considerably facilitated if the old, official German records on German troop training grounds located in the Soviet Zone could be borrowed for some time. (These records include original documents of the former German Commander of the Replacement Training Army, or of the Training Section of the former German Army General Staff.)

(3) Type of Training

(a) The information obtained presented the following picture:

In accordance with the training regulations of the Soviet Army basic training of the individual soldier or in small groups (squad, platoon, company) is being emphasized. This type of training and instruction with special weapons may have been the primary consideration until July 1949. Larger exercises may have been carried through occasionally, but even then the basic small-unit training will have been emphasized by the troop units, while the command elements were being instructed in the cooperation of all arms (troop movements, practice marches, command post exercises). In this connection, it is noteworthy that "wheel components" were distinguished from "tank components" at maneuvers of motorized units. This observation, which was repeatedly made, indicates a still more specialized training. The same tendency is revealed by the concentration of nearly all AAA units at the Letzling Heath from May to July 1949. Not only independent AAA units, but also AAA battalions or rifle, mechanized and tank divisions participated in this specific training. Exact information

on the subjects, aims and level of the maneuvers is, naturally, only seldom supplied, as the Soviet training centers are even more hermetically sealed against the civilian population than the Soviet Military Posts.

(b) Large-scale maneuvers, (maneuvers of combined-arms units from regimental level up) may have been carried out only occasionally.

d. Strength and Age of Personnel

(1) General

From the arrival of numerous recruits, observed from the spring until the summer of 1949, and the increased utilization of both cadre armies as training units, it is to be inferred that personnel strength is greater in 1949 than in 1948. Though it would be of great interest to obtain comparable strength figures, such a computation would have to be based on exact data supplied by several reliable and competent sources (deserters) from various units, which was not available to this project during the past months.

(2) Recruits

(a) Shipments of recruits were still observed in various parts of the Soviet Zone in June 1949. In most cases these shipments may have been in connection with the transfer of recruits from collecting points to field unit posts. Very few shipments of enlisted personnel were observed coming from the SU in June 1949. These were either the last of the recruits or small contingents of specialists to be assigned to Soviet troop units or agencies. It is possible that these shipments also included guard units for SMA installations and skilled workers to replace dismissed German labor in ammunition depots, repair shops and storage depots. Information [redacted] of the arrival of about 25,000 men, routed from the SU via FRANKFURT/Oder into the THUR area from 24 June to 3 July 1949, has not been confirmed [redacted]

(b) The bulk of the recruits from the SU who arrived in the Soviet Zone of Germany from the spring until the summer of 1949 may belong to the 1923/1929 classes, the 1929 class being more frequently mentioned. [redacted]

Individual reports indicating that members of older classes were returned by groups to the SU have been received from time to time since the spring of 1949 [redacted]

[redacted] The number of shipments of soldiers discharged to the SU observed since the spring of 1949 is far lower than the number of inbound shipments of recruits. This was recently confirmed [redacted] that numerous soldiers of the 1925 class were still with the occupation troops in Thuringia in the summer of 1949.

g. Traffic Situation

(1) Dismantling of Rails

The following branch lines were shut down and are being dismantled to obtain rails for trunk railroad lines:

- (a) Single-track section SALLGAST-KOSTEBRASU (west of SENFTENBERG).
- (b) Single-track section PEGAU-GROITZSCH (south of LEIPZIG).

(2) Reconstruction of Railroad Lines

- (a) The single-track TEMPLIN-ZEHDENICK line (north of BERLIN) was reconstructed and put into operation (see expansion of the TEMPLIN training area, par. 2c).
- (b) The second track of the KOSRIGSWUSTLERHAUSEN-MILDAU section was reconstructed and put into operation.
- (c) The AUS-NIEDERSCHLEMA and FAHRBRUECKE-WIESSENBURG sections of the ZWICKAU-AUS line (uranium mining area) were reconstructed as double-track sections and put into operation.

(3) Operations

The effects of the strike of WEST BERLIN railroad employees are still felt. The traffic block of 184 trains accumulated in the Soviet Zone in late June 1949 was decreased to about 80 trains in late July 1949.

(4) Miscellaneous

- (a) Owing to the deficit of the Soviet Zone railroads, the 26 million Eastmark 1949 bridge building program (replacement of emergency bridges by permanent structures) had to be reduced to 15 million, resulting in a suspension of nearly 50 percent of all bridge building projects, which are urgently required for the improvement of operations.
- (b) To counteract the scarcity of raw materials, the SMA issued a detailed order to the Main Traffic Administration advising the railroad, river shipping and motor traffic agencies to collect and utilize all types of used materials (rails, girders and spare parts) for reconstruction and repair purposes. This is only a temporary stopgap measure and will not ease the strained supply situation without large-scale imports from the West.

3. Austria/Hungarya. General

Reports received from 10 July to 10 August 1949 indi-
cate no essential change in the previous OB picture
of the Soviet Occupation Troops in Austria and Hungary
(Central Group of Forces), to July 1949. No noticeable
reinforcements were observed.

b. Strength, Organization and Disposition of Troops

(1) The previous organization and disposition of the three combat divisions was generally confirmed as follows:

(a) 95th Gds Mtz Rifle Div in the western section of the Soviet zone of Austria.

(b) 13th Gds Mecz Div in the eastern section of the Soviet zone of Austria.

(c) 17th Gds Mecz Div in the border area of Western Hungary.

(2) A C-source identified the STOCKERAU AAA units in late July 1949, as the 2500th AAA Regt of the 13th Gds Mecz Div. According to the numbering system known for AAA regiments, the numerical designation "2500" is considered possible (the 2501st AAA Regt is supposedly assigned to the 17th Gds Mecz Div in Western Hungary). In accordance with other information, the 23rd AAA Div was in STOCKERAU and KORNEUBURG. It is improbable that AAA units of the 13th Gds Mecz Div (2500th AAA Regt) and of the 23rd AAA Div are stationed in the KORNEUBURG-STOCKERAU area. It is considered possible that the 23rd AAA Div is not there (see [redacted]). Further information on this issue is required.

(3) The assignment of a tank unit located in BRUCK on the Leitha River is not yet clear (15th Tank Regt of the 13th Gds Mecz Div or 170th Tank Regt as GHQ unit of the Central Group of Forces [redacted]).

(4) The Soviet border troops were not observed to have been reinforced until early July 1949. No changes in the disposition of troops were observed, particularly in the area south of Lake Balaton. The reports of the alleged concentration of Soviet troops along the Yugoslav border, therefore, cannot be confirmed by this project (see par.4).

(5) Annex 2 gives a survey of the organization, disposition and strength of the Soviet Occupation Troops in Austria and Hungary.

c. Training and Maneuvers

(1) Most units of the Central Group of Forces were still at the troop training grounds in July 1949.

(2) Concerning movements to the training grounds and the extent and objects of maneuvers, the same applies as has been said regarding the Soviet Occupation Troops in Germany (see par.2c).

(3) The recruits who arrived during the spring of 1949 were in most cases transferred to the training grounds with the field units. In some cases the recruits who arrived later, however, were still being trained in the military posts in July and July 1949.

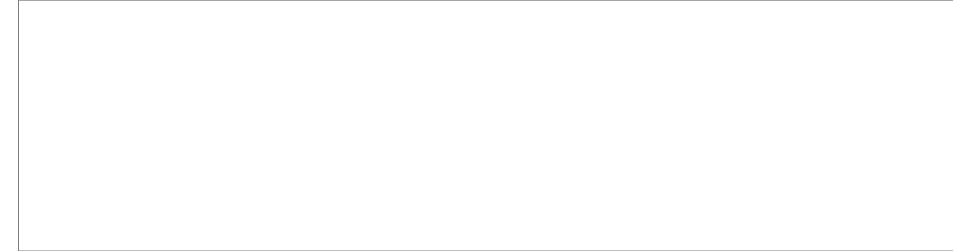

d. Strength, and Age of Personnel

Small contingents of recruits still arrived from the SU in the summer of 1949. Members of older classes were returned to the SU by groups, at staggered intervals, the proportion of returnees in relation to the strength of troop units being the same as in the Soviet Zone of Germany.

4. Rumaniaa. General

The reports from Rumania from 10 July to 10 August do not give a clear OS picture of the Soviet troops stationed there.

b. Training and Maneuvers

According to information obtained in June and July 1949 [redacted] Soviet maneuvers were apparently carried out in Little Wallachia and in the Danate (border area of TULISOARA) during the period of observation. Troops mainly of the CRAIOVA-SIATINA area may have participated in the maneuvers, as in 1948. The participation of some Rumanian units was also reported. Maneuvers of Soviet artillery units were reported from the DADILOW artillery training grounds, which is known from previous reports as the main artillery training grounds of Rumania [redacted]

c. Disposition

The Soviet troops stationed in Rumania are still mainly in the following areas:

Little Wallachia (CRAIOVA-SIATINA area)
Greater Wallachia (BUKAREST area)
Southern Moldavia (GALATI/BRAILA area)
Dobrudja CONSTANTA area).

d. Strength and Fighting Morale

In connection with the tension between the Cominform and TITO, Yugoslavian press reports have dealt, for some time, with the strength and fighting morale of the Soviet troops stationed along the Yugoslav borders. Although a clear picture of the Soviet troops in Rumania is at present unobtainable (see par. 4a), available information makes possible a comparison with former similar situations. Alarming news of a Soviet strategic concentration in Little Wallachia were received in late summer and fall of 1948, reporting the assembly of nineteen divisions etc. These reports then, as now, were based on available information, which was of as little value as at present, that the rumors were exaggerated was later confirmed by reports on the occupation of military posts.

evaluation of present information again supports the opinion that recent news of concentration of Soviet troops along the Yugoslav borders (and thus the considerable reinforcement of Soviet troops in Rumania) is to be regarded only as rumor.

5. Poland and Polish-Occupied Silesia and Pomerania

Reports received from Poland and Polish-occupied Silesia and Pomerania from 10 July to 10 August 1949 contained no essential data on the OB of the Soviet troops stationed there.

6. Inner Russia

a. The following commanders-in-chief of Military Districts were again confirmed by evaluation of the Soviet press (which, unfortunately, was only in individual issues available:

(1) Genpolk N.P. PUKHOV as C-in-C of the Odessa MD until 10 June 1949 (Pravda).

(2) Genarmy I.Ye. PETROV as C-in-C of the Turkestan MD until 10 June 1949 (Pravda).

b. Summary reports on troops and supply installations of individual MDs were compiled on the basis of a very large number of interrogation reports on former German PWs discharged since the summer of 1948. The following have been dealt with during recent weeks: Baltic MD (including supplements), Leningrad MD, Belorussian MD, and Carpathian MD. These summary reports, which will be compiled for all MDs, for the first time, give a credible picture of the troops stationed in garrisons or the SU. Although this data does not make possible any troop unit identification, at least for the time being, it does constitute a valuable supplement to the study "Assumed Distribution of Troops in the MDs of the SU, which was compiled by this project in the fall of 1948 ([redacted])

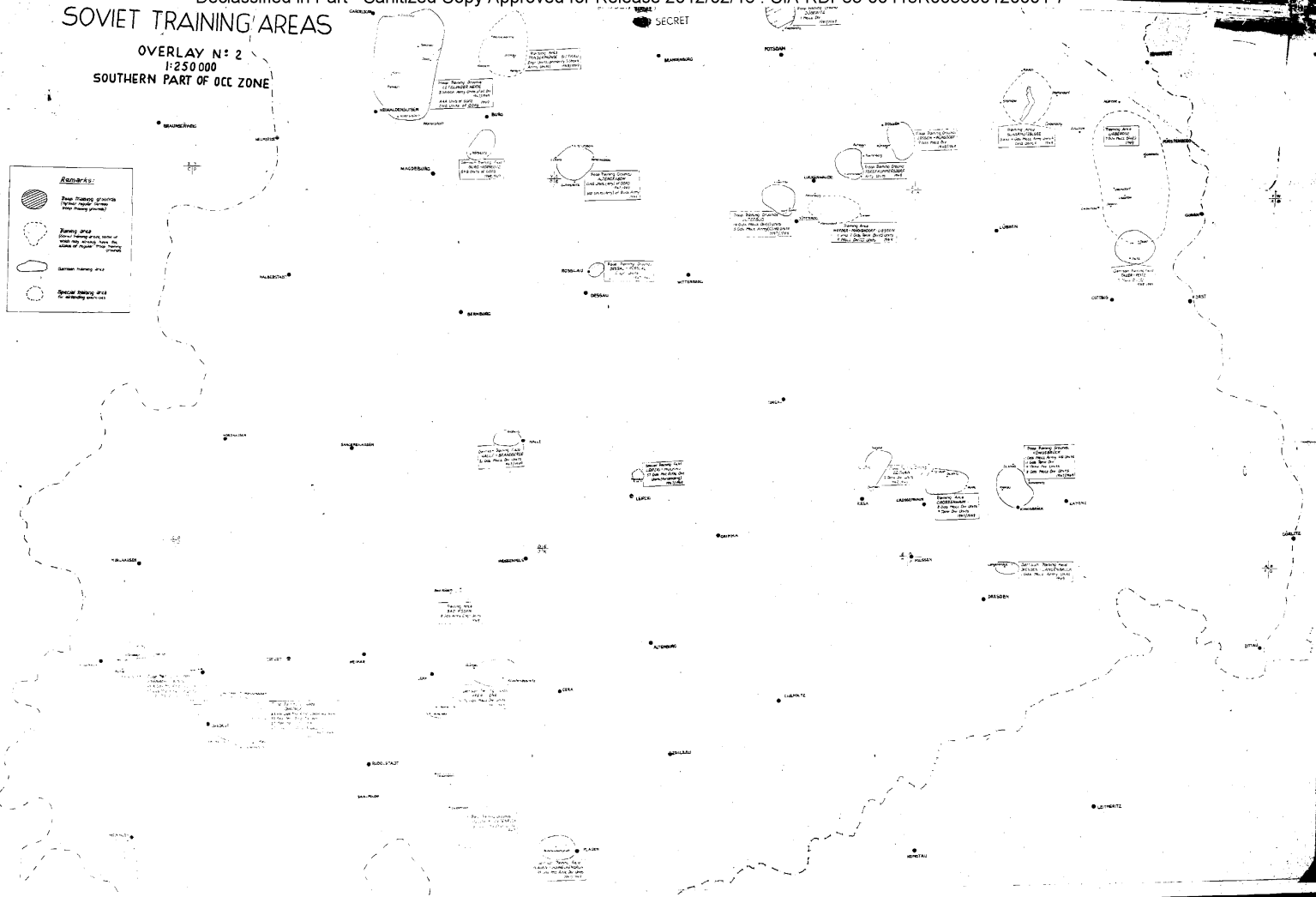
