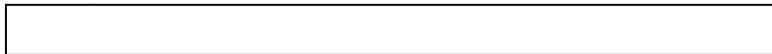

Emanuel Grin.</p> <p>After the conclusion of the Congress, the delegates to the Congress, both those from Poland and foreign countries, left Warsaw for larger centers in the country where they addressed mass meetings. 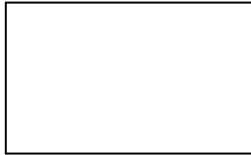
