QUEEN ALIYA PASSES AWAY AFTER LONG ILLNESS.

Yesterday morning, December 21, 1950, at 9:20 a.m., Queen Aliya, mother of King Feisal II and sister of Regent Abdul Ilah, passed away after a long illness.

The Regent announced her death to the Iraqi people from Wasr Ez-Zehour over the Baghdad Radio. (Text published in the afternoon edition of the Iraq Times of December 21, 1950)

In the afternoon, king Abdulla, of Jordan, arrived in Baghdad to attend the Queen's funeral slated for this morning. The Queen's remains were transported to the Royal Bilat yesterday afternoon. This morning the funeral ceremony will start from there to the Royal Mausoleum at Adhamiya.

For forty days, flags will be flown at half-mast over Royal nouses, and for six months the Royal Bilat will be in mourning as from the funeral day. Dinema-houses will be closed for three days. Night clubs will be closed for seven days.

It is announced that the "Fatiha" for the soul of Queen Aliya will be held at the Royal Bilat for three days, as from Friday, December 22, 1950. On Friday, it will be between 3 p.m. and 6 p.m., and on Saturday and Sunday from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 a.m. and from 3:00 p.m. to 6 p.m.

As for ladies, the "Fatiha" will be at Wasr Ez-Zehour for the same three days, from ll:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. (Al-Ittihad Ad-Dasturi)
