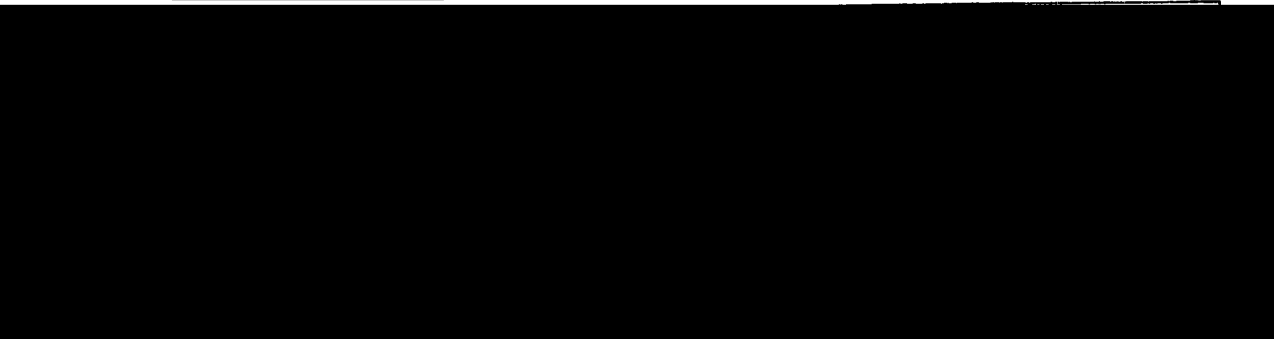

1. Large-scale maneuvers of the Soviet Army took place in the Primorski Krai [REDACTED]
2. Among the units participating in these maneuvers were the 21st, 22nd, and 23rd infantry divisions, the 7th and 8th cavalry divisions, the 27th heavy artillery regiment, the 12th tank division, the 17th and 18th air brigades, and various air units.
3. The maneuvers were offensive in character. The troops attacked from the area of Voroshilov (43-47N, 131-54E)-Ussurka (45-12N, 133-13E)-Razdolnoye (43-33N, 131-55E) in the direction of Poset (42-39N, 131-22E), Barabash (43-12N, 131-22E), and Novo-Kiyevsk (not located). The mock-attack thus was directed toward the Soviet frontier with China and Korea.
4. The maneuvers were commanded by [Marshal] Kirill A. Meretskov. *600*

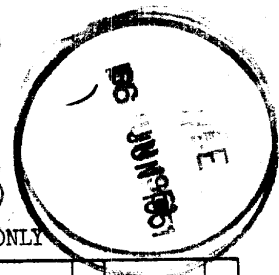
