1. Metallimport Trust Zurich, through its Vienna representative [REDACTED] is offering the Central Commercial Bureau of USIA the items listed below. Prices are in dollars per ton unless otherwise noted.
  - a. 1,000 tons of greased sheet metal for car bodies, can be deep drawn, .625 to 2 mm by one meter by two meters, f.o.b. Antwerp, \$396.
  - b. 2,000 tons of SAE sheet metal of German origin for car bodies, rolled hot twice, cold once, pickled twice, 500 tons .5 to 1 mm, 500 tons (sic) 1.25 to 2 mm f.o.b. Antwerp, \$405.50.
  - c. 200 tons of basic sheet metal .5 to .6 mm by 1,000 mm by 200 to 1,000 mm, edge trimmed, now, immediate delivery f.o.b. German port, \$292.
  - d. 200 tons of medium and heavy plate, weldable, .021-.022 (sic), 4 to 9 mm by 1,000 mm by 2,000 mm, f.o.b. German port, \$298.
  - e. 31 tons of cold rolled hoop iron of normal working length, one-third of which is 65 by 1.75 mm, the rest 80 by 1.75 mm, prompt delivery from a Vienna storage point, 4.60 (sic) schillings per kilo.
  - f. 2,500 to 3,000 tons of Siemens-Martin steel "H.P. Profil I", 80 and 120 (sic) and 120 mm by 12 to 14 meters, f.o.b. Antwerp, \$171.
  - g. 900 tons of Spiegelleisen, containing carbon 5 to 6%, silicon 1%, manganese 24 to 25%, sulphur .04%, phosphorus .2%, c.i.f. Rotterdam, Hamburg or Genoa, \$148.
  - h. 10,000 tons of chrome-nickel and chrome-molybdenum alloy [REDACTED] a French port, \$134.50.
  - i. 5,000 meters of drilling rods weighing about 20 kilos per meter, 9.374 mm thick, lengths to 13 meters, "API Grad D 3 and 1/2 Zoll", thread-protective caps both ends, c.i.f. the Austrian border or Vienna, 10.50 schillings per kilo.

- j. 30 tons of paraffin c.i.f. Vienna, 10.30 schillings per kilo.
  - k. 500 cubic meters of beech plywood, grades II and III, 45% 5 mm, 45% 6 mm, the rest 8 to 12 mm polished and coated on one side, delivery in Vienna, 4575 schillings.
  - l. 50 tons of potassium permananate, \$822.
  - m. 70 tons of crystalline phenol, \$1,129.
  - n. 50 to 100 tons of potassium bichromate, \$880.
  - o. 25 tons of potassium hydroxide, \$872.
  - p. 50 to 60 tons of igelit "marked G", \$1,091.
  - q. 50 tons of potassium nitrate, 99 to 100% pure, \$215. 25X1X
