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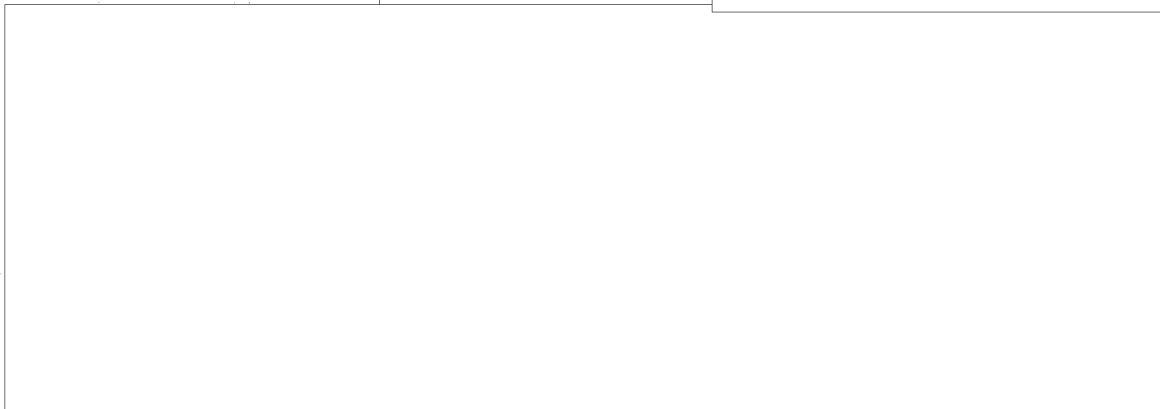

Ships under construction

At the time indicated in the margin the following ships were under construction:

- 4 ships of the Locchi type (displacement, 4,000 tons), including:
 - 1 with hull completed and the superstructure now

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being built

- 1 with the keel half completed.

- 2 with keels now being laid.

Ships launched.

In October 1950 a 200-horsepower tugboat was launched. This was the sixth tugboat launched at the shipyard over a period of 5 months (all six tugboats were alike).

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still under construction.

Jan 51 - Scoglio Olivi shipyard.

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Manager: an army major.

Personnel: In January 1951

there were 400 persons employed there, including laborers and administrative personnel.

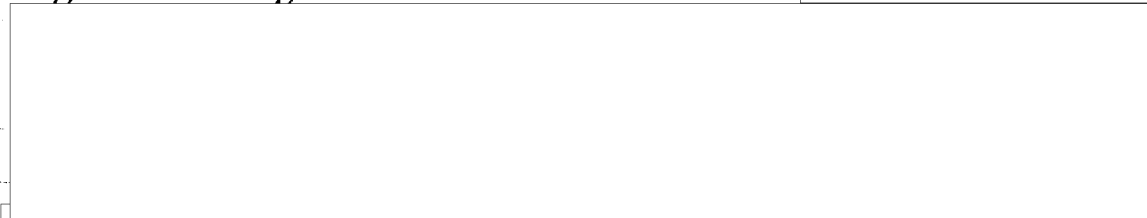
Schedule: The workers follow the following work schedule:

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Dock

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The following ships are under construction there at present:

- 6 500-ton ships of the *ABBAZIA* class for coastal ships. 3 of these are 54.80 meters long and their hulls are nearly completed. Within a month they will be brought to the nearby shipyard to be fitted out. The other 3 ships are 56.80 meters long; work on their construction began only 3 months ago.

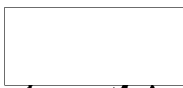

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preparations were being made at the shipyard

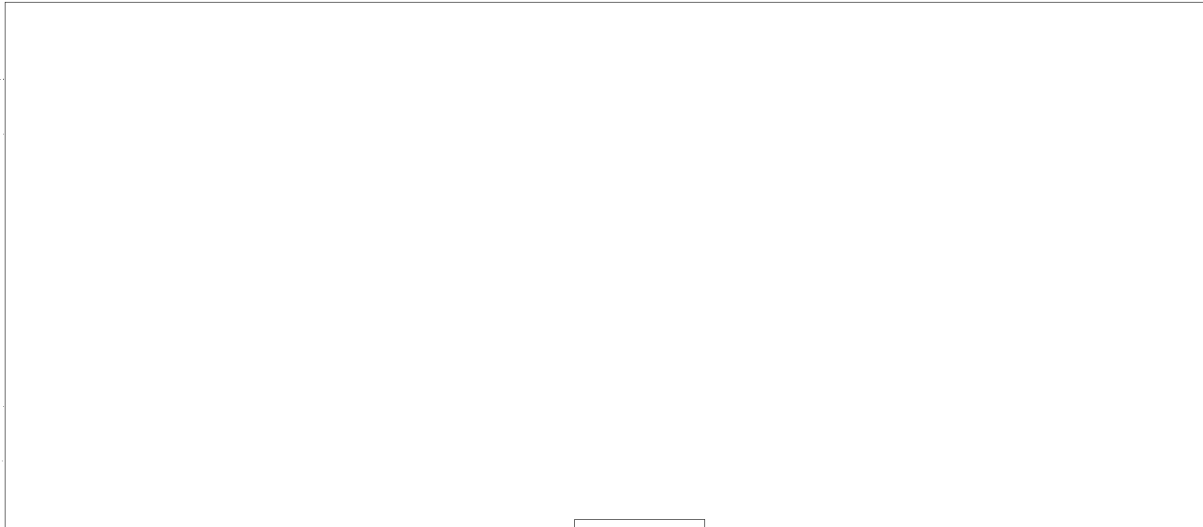
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for submersion tests; thus far, however, not a single such test has been made.
