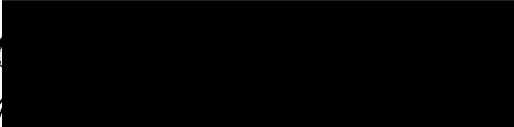

This ^{amount} refers to the date in the margin when the source was still working there; now he understands that the movement has decreased a great deal.

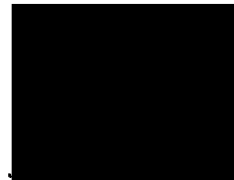

Workers Assigned

A few civilians ^{are} employed in the management and the remaining workers ~~of the camp~~ ^{consist} of 500 prisoners, divided into squads of 50 men headed by a prisoner who was chosen among those who ~~had~~ a long sentence to serve.

The squads were then divided into smaller ones, composed of 10 men each, headed by a prisoner as previously described.

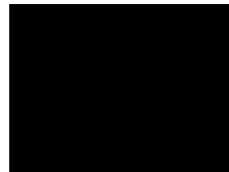

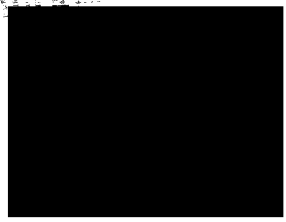

- bread ^(cornbread): 300 grams per day (corn)
