The top floor was occupied by the director and offices.

- Shed, supported by 20 wooden ~~cross~~ beams, used as carpenter shop
 - Building about 30 x 12 meters which housed ~~the~~ GATTER type saws.
- The lumber was piled in the open in the courtyard of the factory.

Origin of raw material

- about 15 carloads a day come from SLOVENIA
- about 20 tons ~~from~~ the forests of RODOV^{LJ}LICA (BLED/SN-EO) transported ~~with the~~ by the vehicles at the disposal of the factory.

Production

Doors, windows, tables, demountable barracks.

Destination of production

FOR the most part it is sent to BELGRADE where ~~work~~ construction work is under way on the NEW BELGRADE.
