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SUBJECT Civil Flight Restrictions

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1. Civil flight restrictions were imposed on the following Soviet airline routes on the dates indicated:

- a. 25 July 1951 - Moscow-Odessa, Moscow-Warsaw, Kulbyshev-Moscow, Saratov-Moscow;
- b. 7 August 1951 - Moscow-Adler;
- c. 11 August 1951 - Adler-Moscow;
- d. 7 August 1951 - East of Irkutsk, probably (sic);
- e. 10 Sept. 1951 - Moscow-Simferopol;
- f. 5,9-10 Sept. 1951 on the Moscow line (sic; Moscow to what city not specified).

2. Civil flight prohibitions were imposed as follows:

- a. 8 July 1951 - Moscow-Minsk airline route;
- b. 22 July 1951 - West zone of Moscow;
- c. 29 July 1951 - West zone of Moscow;
- d. 2 August 1951 - Lvov-Moscow airline route.

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3. Landing prohibitions were imposed as follows:

- a. 1 July 1951 - Minsk;
- b. 8 July 1951 - Minsk;
- c. 3 July 1951 - Semipalatinsk;
- d. 25 July 1951 - Vnukovo and one other unspecified Moscow airfield.

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Comment: The exact nature and duration of the flight restrictions which were imposed were not specified.



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
