1. Tewa-Neustadt/Orla production of screen Number 231 was 11,119 square meters in April 1952 and 11,730 square meters in May 1952. Both lots were of first quality.
2. At Tewa-Neustadt, the output of the reed shop was 50 reeds Number 231 in April 1952 and the same quantity in May 1952.
3. As of 21 June 1952, no new production order for screen Number 231 had been received.
4. Some unspecified equipment (not looms) was transferred to Russia at a recent unspecified date. [Redacted] the possibility of an eventual transfer to Russia of the entire plant is not excluded. This belief is based on the fact that equipment has been transferred to Russia, and that no new production orders have been received.
5. Stesnov left for Russia on official leave on 21 May 1952. He has not yet returned. [Redacted] Stesnov's leave is a pretext, and [Redacted] he went to Russia to receive new instructions in Moscow. Palilov is taking Stesnov's place during the latter's absence. Palilov is scheduled to take up permanent residence in Neustadt/Orla in the near future. Pandorenko, a newly-arrived Russian from the Reparations Office in Karlshorst, is Palilov's assistant.
6. Two German acceptance officials, Schneider and Kabierske, were recently dismissed, as a result of a Moscow complaint that inferior quality screen had been approved for acceptance. The two Germans have been replaced by two unidentified acceptance officials from Zeulenroda.
