This shipyard also has a large floating crane with a lifting capacity of about 120 tons.

c. Data relating to the production of the Stocznia Gdanska.

Very little information is available relative to the activities of this yard. But it is known that 6 trawlers of the same type as the Polish trawlers REGA and RADUNIA were constructed for the Russians. However, these trawlers are from 3 to 4 meters shorter than the REGA and the RADUNIA and have a different type of bridge and stack. The Russian trawlers have a tonnage of about 612 to 615 G.R.T.

The machinery of four of these vessels is also of another type, that is, the so-called double compound Friedrichstad steam engines, 1100 I.H.P.
