- 1. LUBLIN: Reserve Officers' Training [redacted]
- 2. SLUPSK: An armored unit is stationed here. Possibly a regiment of self-propelled Artillery (artylerja samobiezna). [redacted] 50X1-HUM

3. ELBLAG: At a distance of 1,500 to 2,000 m. South of ELBLAG lies a Polish-Soviet military aerodrome. Fighters of the YAK and MIG type as well as JUNKER a/c used as transport planes were observed on this aerodrome. The entire aerodrome has been surfaced with concrete.

4. SKAWSKA POREBA: There are two Radar stations here; one located in the former German hotel "Reiftragerbaude", the other near the new "WOP" barracks in the northern outskirts of the town.

The commandant of the station in the hotel is Captain Franciszek MICHALSKI (Air Force).
