Both of these men have been raised from the unknown depths (from party ranks) by RAKOSI and been made into high rank party functionaries - with the violation of the party constitution. Previously both of them filled very small posts in the party machinery.

This was necessary that RAKOSI should create a leadership next to himself that are christians (gentiles) and possible of worker origin, that will carry out RAKOSI's will through fire and water. ACS and VEGH are these men.

In the meantime they tasted power and they use it too. They are 30 to 38 years old.

In 1944 as a university student he joined the resistance movement. This way he came into contact with ~~N~~ FEHER Lajos who for a while has been the member of the Central management. AJTAY worked in the resistance movement under the direction of FEHER. Their name is connected with the the blowing up of the GOMBOS monument (6 October 1944 Dobrentei square, at Budapest) and the blowing up of several German Panzers. AJTAY worked in the movement under the cover name of MAROT or SZIR.

At this time AJTAY has not been yet a member of the communist party, and entered the party only after 1945. After his graduation at the university, the party considering Ajtay's services, helped him and placed him in important positions. For years he has been deputy minister for the light industry. At present he is either still in this position or is vice president of the Country Planning Office.

AJTAY is a modest man who does not boast of his deeds of the past.

He does not like to talk about politics. He participates in various political movements only as an obligation. He has been driven into the communist net by *his* unexpressible anti-nazi and anti-arrow-cross stand.

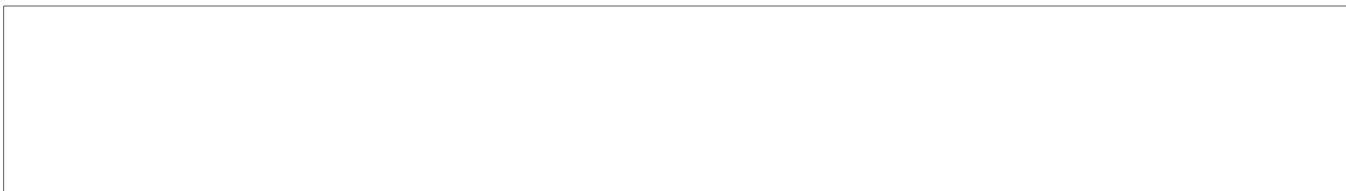

 he already has been a member of the communist party. After 1945 he started 25X1 to work in the labor union. Soon he became secretary, from this position he stepped in the ministerial chair, becomes minister of building materials. Later he is 25X1 deputy of the president of the council of ministers, and holds this job up to now. His original trade was apprentice painter, but could not work much because for years he had to live in illegality. From 1945 until 1948 he used to live in a four room apartment at No.56 Dozsa Gyorgy street, and from there he moved to his present domicile.

He is known as one of the truest man of RAKOSI.  His wife 25X1 also works in the party machinery is first secretary of the party committee of one district.

 he also is a member of that committee 25X1 at the party central that is destined to supervise the RAKJ case.

 He has one brother(or sister) who 25X1 for a long time used to have a flower shop at Budapest. His original name was: KLEIN Antal.

He is RAKOSI's man, since 2-3 years he is ^{also a} member of the political committee of the party.

BALOGH, Elemer.

His name is unknown. However in the Hungarian political life he already played a great role in the past and will continue it in the future. He is the director and leader of the highest party highschool at Budapest.

Before 1945, he has ~~been~~ been professor at the Tisza Istvan university (Debrecen). Even at that time he had communist sympathies. His theoretical knowledge has been great but he has joined the communist party only after the Russian troops occupied Debrecen. He also has been graduated at several party high schools and party academies -and primarily in the Soviet Union. At present he is the director of the education and the upbringing of the upper cadres.

BALOGH condu~~ct~~cts the party high schools exactly and completely according to the Soviet system. He himself directs only a small number of schools attended ~~by~~ only by members of the central management of the party and a few ministers. Several times he has been selected (for higher posts) but always he declined that he still has plenty to do on this(educational) field. Until he ~~he~~ does not see the party educational system good enough he is not going to take any other position. Twice he has been selected as minister of education. Once his nomination has been approved by all the competent authorities and only the publication was necessary, however he decidedly declined to accept. He declared that in a few years time the time will come when he will be able to comply gladly to a similar will of the party.

The party functinaries are very much after his good will and graces. Namely, the assignment of education and the grading and classification mostly depend on him, and the more ambitious party members would like to get there(to his classes). Even the members of the Central management of the party fear BALOGH's opinion less he states about them that they are ideologically undeveloped -and therefore the grey, insignificant man in the back~~g~~round has tremendous power.

BALOGH is a clever, well-balanced, sober minded, sharp-brained man. Speaks Russian, German and English.

BATA, Istvan

Defense minister. [redacted] There are two versions in 25X1
circulation in the country about BATA. The one, that he has been a street car
conductor and has been recruited by KOSSA Istvan, and the other, that around
1945 he came from Moscow and right away became the chief of staff of the army.

personality appears at a public place, he is followed by the AVH men who at
once report to their central where they are and when. At two occasions when
BATTA arrived at the Peoples Park(Nepliget) soccer field to see the Honved
(ARMY) game, the same procedure was followed in his case. The AVH man used the
sport newspaper's telephone to report thus; " The KAKADEK arrived at such and
such a time "

It is interesting that the KAKADEK covername was used at two occasion in
connection with BATTA.

BEBRITS, Lajos

transportation minister.

He came back to Hungary in 1945. He participated in the first revolution and after its defeat he had to escape. Allegedly at that time he used to work at the railroad. Between the two world wars he lived several years in the United States (Cleveland, Ohio) and from there went to the Soviet Union. After 1945 he first became secretary of state for transportation, next to minister Gero, and then from 1946 he is minister without interruption. He is a confidential man of the Russians, this is understandable because the mail and railroad is important from the point of view of the army, and these belong under BEBRITS' jurisdiction.

BEBRITS likes to drink. He has a few friends, who have smaller vineyards around Tokaj and Badacsony, and he visits them often with the ministerial special train. BEBRITS has a 25-28 year old daughter who is working in the editorial offices of the "Szabad Nep" (Free People) under the name of BEBRITS Anna, as newspaperwoman. This woman is unbelievably on the communist line. She plays more of a communist than her father.

The BEBRITS ministry has plenty of difficulties. They started the construction of the subway, that had to be discontinued, and the openings (shafts) stand now all over the city. A few houses collapsed. The question of responsibility has been brought up several times at party meetings but BEBRITS is not very much interested because he acted on GERO Erno's instructions. It could be said about BEBRITS that he enjoys the confidence of GERO Erno in the first place. BEBRITS had an active part in the hanging of VARGA Laszlo (or Istvan) the former general director of the

She traveled abroad several time as peace delegate. She does not know much about radio but she is a party faithful and very much on the line. Since 1947 she is member of the parliament. Her monthly income reaches to about 5-6000 forints.

BERCZI or BARCZI, Gyula, first secretary of the party committee of Bihar-Hajdu county.

At one occasion they (the communist leaders) wanted to promote him. After the March 1955 party resolution they wanted to put him in the presidency of the Country Planning Office. He openly said that he does not accept the job because he does not know anything about it. This frank admission only raised his prestige.

He is still there. He is a completely Moscow man together with his wife.

BETLEN is the brother of BOLDIZSAR Ivan the editor in chief of the Magyar Nemzet (Hungarian Nation)paper. He with his brother participated in the illegal struggle before 1945. In 1945 he joined the communist party and started to work at the "Szabad Nep ". After REVAI left the paper, BETLEN became the deputy of HORVATH Marton, and therefore he is the second man at the paper. He filled this position more or less until 1953 when he became the editor in chief of the "Tartos Bekert es Nepi Demokraciaert"(For the Permanent Peace and for the Peoples Democracy) news information bureau paper published at Bucarest.

He has been relieved a few months ago, went back to Budapest and for a while he did not do any work. Since about October (1955) he is reengaged at the "Szabad Nep" and is the deputy head of the editorial committee.

BETLEN is married.

BOGNAR started in the Small Landowners Party on the left wing. As such he succeeded making a ^{career} carrier for himself because he supported the communist in he was everything. For years a penetrating agent (of the communists) in the landowners party and informed the communists of every move.

For a time he was editor of the "Reggel" Monday paper that belonged to LAZAR Miklos. He was delegated to this post by the party. Later he was mayor of Budapest, and had some post at the ministry of information. At this time he was barely 2 30 years old. Later he was upgraded to minister of interior commerce. He ~~did~~ did not know anything about this job but having accustomed to the good life he did not want to leave it and accepted the nomination.

[redacted] he since 1946 always filled important posts.

RAKOSI rates him highly because way back in 1946 when bourgeois politicians had not recognised yet the communist tactics, BOGNAR was up to date and was the first to study the so-called classics of the Marxist literature. At this time he lived in an apartment at the FEHER Gyorgy street [redacted] but later 25X1 he too moved up to the Rozsa hill. His position has been shaky for a year or two,- his old and faithful secretary has been transferred from his side and is today the head of one of the agricultural export enterprises,- and a former manicurist girl has been designated by the party to his side. This girl is the observer of BOGNAR. BOGNAR's name is closely connected with the liquidation of private commerce in Hungary. Under his ministership every shop, store and enterprise has been socialized. He is a typical opportunist, today he serves this system but tomorrow if his interest demands he will serve something else.

BOLDIZSAR, Ivan

newspaperman.

BOLDIZSAR has been a newspaperman even before 1945. However, after 1943 he could not write under his name because of his origin. By this reason he became very bitter at this time and in 1944 had financial difficulties also, he could hardly make a living. Around this time he joined the anti-nazi underground movement and soon edited an illegal underground newspaper. This became known, BOLDIZSAR has been arrested, and spent months at the Margit boulevard military prison. After 1945 he started on the political line. His brother, BETLEN Oscar joined the communists, but he BOLDIZSAR selected the National Peasant Party. He became the editor of the "Szabad Szo" the organ of the Peasant Party, however he does not edit the paper for a long time *any more*.

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Before long, he starts a new weekly under the title of "Uj Magyarorszag" (New Hungary) with the task to prove to the world—and also to the Hungarians— that Hungary has a legal right to demand the Hungarian inhabited part of Transylvania, and the Hungarian inhabited part of Upper-Hungary (Czechoslovakia), and also to give to the Hungarian public a weekly magazine treating foreign affairs measured with Western standards. For a while his paper prospered well, in case of need once the ministry of foreign affairs and then the ~~the~~ ministry of cults and public instruction (of that time) helped him out ~~with~~ materially, remaining in the background.

Since 1945, 1946. Boldizsar had a burning desire, he wanted to become minister of foreign affairs. He worked for this purpose in the Peasant Party, and this was the reason he was on good terms with everybody. However, his dream did not come true, he reached the rank of secretary of state, and already he was very much satisfied. It belongs to human nature that he used many newspapermen to reach

this post but when he attained his goal, he asked everybody who helped him, how he could reciprocate their assistance. However, in the chair of the secretary of state shifted more and more to the left in the direction of Moscow. From his position as secretary of state BOLDIZSAR went back to the editorship of the "Magyar Nemzet" illustrated weekly daily and the "Beke es Szabadsag"(Peace and Freedom). He has been editor of these two papers at the same time. Soon he resigned from the "Beke es Szabadsag" and kept only the "Magyar Nemzet" until ~~1953~~/ 1955. From this post he was relieved in a very interesting manner. At that time there has been a great cleaning up process in progress in the Hungarian press. The "Magyar Nemzet" has been the paper of the Patriotic Peoples Front that served NAGY Imre and his system devotedly. Therefore, it was to be expected that some people will be fired from that paper too. And so it happened. After the first waves calmed down BOLDIZSAR declared that he knows for certain that nobody else will be fired from the paper. everybody should be reassured (steady) now. The same day he, BOLDIZSAR has been called up to the party central at the Akademia street, and he has been fired. This news surprised not only BOLDIZSAR but the whole Hungarian press also.

BOLDIZSAR is a very smart, educated and sly man. When he saw that one has to change direction toward Moscow, he went to the Soviet Union and from there wrote a book "Fortochka". this book, more than anything else, popularized the Soviet Union in Hungary. The book dealt with everyday problems. One part of the party, led by RAKOSI, praised the book, and the other part of the party (REVAI) reproached BOLDIZSAR. In November 1955 he had no position yet, . His wife is of French origin (French girl) and has relatives living in France, she still speaks better French than Hungarian. BOLDIZSAR lives in the beautiful house (villa) of KORNIC Gyula, former professor of university at the Balogh Adam street. For a long time BOLDIZSAR paid rent, but when the ~~house~~

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BOLDIZSAR Ivan

house has been nationalized, as a few months later he discontinued the payments of rent to KORNIS.

BOLDIZSAR Ivan has every single book that was published in Hungary since 1945.

He has an unbelievably valuable library. He himself is an educated, clever man.

Several times he travel^d abroad, also on the West.

As an oppressed man he aspired for much more and believed that through his talents, ~~he~~ and capacity he shall achieve more. Now he is bypassed and neglected more and more permanently. There were times when his monthly income reached 12-15.000 forints (and this is no mistake). At present he is working at the shortwave broadcasts of the Radio, that is directed to abroad. Most of the times he wrote the political comments to the Arabian language programs. Just recently, one of his books has been published "Travel guide of Hungary" that describes and presents the more famous resorts and excursion places.

BOLDIZSAR, Ivan (Comments of translator to biography of)

BOLDIZSAR Ivan was born around 1906, graduated from high school around 1924, (probably latin high school) attended university at Budapest for two or three years (Law and political sciences) received his degree in 1928. (?)

In 1927 BOLDIZSAR was awarded scholarship of the Hungarian Ministry of Foreign affairs, for one or two years study at the Sorbonne university at Paris.

Arrived at Paris October 1927, lived at the left bank, studied at Sorbonne, political sciences and French language. June 1928 went back to Hungary (summer vacations) returned in September same year. In April 1929 BOLDIZSAR still lived in Paris and continued his studies. [redacted] 25X1

On his way to success, BOLDIZSAR encountered the same obstacles and had the same 25X1 opinion as RAJK Laszlo did " to achieve success in Hungary one has to be a nobleman, a count, or baron, or such". However, BOLDIZSAR found an easier way to circumvent the difficulties due to his humble origin. He joined already at Budapest at the university some of the patriotic student organisations and played an active part in their activities. He became one of the leaders, and it was said about him that he was granted the scholarship to reward him for his patriotic efforts in the student associations.

At Paris also, BOLDIZSAR was one of the leaders of the Hungarian youth (there were about 40 scholarship students and ^{about} ~~many~~ 150 other students who learned at their own expense) participated in discussions, lectures, debates and made a good name for himself among his fellow students. BOLDIZSAR was very patriotic and very Hungarian, much more so than the average Hungarian, because he had to be, due to his origin.

When DOBI Istvan became president of the council of ministers,

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CSATO Istvan became the head of the secretariat. It is natural and also it is certain that he received this post upon the recommendation of the party and the AVH. CSATO worked at this post until DOBI has been prime minister. When DOBI became state president, CSATO for a while directed the secretariat temporarily but later has been transferred to the press line by the party. He was placed at the "Szabad Ifkusag"(Free Youth) the ^{(central} paper of the DISZ(Demokratikus Ifjusagi Szovetseg-Democratic Youth Federation) as director of the youth section. His wife under the name of CSATO Eva is ^(for years now) a collaborator of the "Szabad Nep" the central party paper.

Financially they live a balanced life with his wife, they earn about ⁴⁰⁰⁰⁻4.500- forints per month. In any case CSATO is hurt now that the party transferred him back to the paper. He would much rather ^{be} at the secretariat of one of the leaders as the head of the secretariat.

DARVAS, Joseph, Peoples Education Minister.

167-169 cm.tall, brown straight hair combed back, his age is about 44-46 years, married, has wife and two or three children.

DARVAS is the son of simple peasant parents, he finished his schooling with great difficulties. His name was made known in the beginning of the 1940ies, when he wrote a series of reports in the "Magyarorszag" or the "Az Est" papers about the life of the women of the night (whores). As a young man for a while he was a kept man (pimp) and had an insight ~~in~~^{to} that world. He had a flowing style and presented his subject with thrilling interest. He acquired a good name in the press and belonged to the arrived younger newspapermen set. DARVAS was not satisfied with this prestige, he yearned for the laureat of a writer, and published two^{or} three books, in them he exposed the problems of the simple peasants of the Hungarian village. His books had a striking success. He joined or rather was co-founder of that group of young writers who -being writers, newspapermen, reporters of peasant origin- whipped the Horthy system and brought the problems of the poor landless peasantry into the open, before the Hungarian public. The leaders of this group; FEJA Geza, DARVAS Joseph, KOVACS Imre (he lives now in the United States), ERDEI Ferenc, etc. formed later the leadership of the National Peasant Party.

DARVAS participated in the resistance movement actively, and here too, he mostly fought with his pen. At this time he was rather friendly to America and not a Soviet sympathizer. After 1945 his carrier rose like lightning. First he was editor of the first Hungarian paper the "Szabadsag" together with ZILAHY Lajos ~~Q~~ who since then moved to America), and KALLAI Gyula, the communist. Later he became in chief editor of the "Szabad Szo" the paper of the National Peasant Party. Since 1945 he is representative in the assembly and member of the presidency of the National Peasant Party. Even today, together with ERDEI Ferenc they represent the leaders of the mentioned party.

The communists knew that it will be very difficult to win over the peasantry of the country and therefore they formed and supported the peasant party that was

DARVAS, Joseph.

supposed to become the party of the landless peasants. Here, DARVAS followed the communist tactics, and from the first moment showed himself as the truest ally of the communists. ^{As} His reward, he received the portfolio of the minister of reconstruction. This DARVAS did not want to accept saying that he does not understand this job. RAKOSI convinced him that it is not important what kind of a minister he is but he has to be a minister. As minister of reconstruction he did not accomplish much, his every desire was the position of the minister of education. He did not have to wait long for this either.

As minister of instruction, his name is connected with the introduction of Soviet type education, re-writing of the Hungarian textbooks. During his minister-ship the Hungarian school system has been started to change over to the Soviet methods. DARVAS was minister of instruction for several years and nearly two years ago he has been transferred as head of the Peoples Education Ministry and he is still there. Besides politics DARVAS is still writing. While active minister he published two or three novels which are fairly interesting. Among these works of his the "Felelet"(Answer) and "Szeptemberben"(In September) are worthy of attention. At present one of his novels is adapted for film play.

As first secretary, he simultaneously has been member of the Central Leadership, and there were times when he has been ^{temporarily} ~~even~~ a member of the political committee of the party. Today, he could be about 32-35 years old, as far as I know. When he has reached his 30th year he had to terminate his works at the DISZ, and has been transferred to the party line. First, for ^a short period he has been at the party center, then has been transferred to Zalaegerszeg at the head of the county party committee. This is a very high post in the communist ranks. It could be presumed that in very short time Denes shall receive a ^{much} higher post. While in Zala county, DENES acquired the necessary practical experience. He is member of parliament. He has one fault that is attempted to be covered now, the anti-Tito campaign has been accentuated at the most in Zala and Baranya counties. DENES has been the active director of this anti-Tito campaign in Zala county. RAKOSI has a high regard for DENES.

When the DISZ published a daily newspaper -on the example of the ^{the wife of DENES} ~~Komszomol~~ KOMSZOMOL - ~~the first editor of the paper~~ KATONA Edith became the first editor of the paper. This has been reproached to him but RAKOSI defended him with his full weight. Since then the wife resigned this position and now performs smaller, larger work at the various mass movements. (Peace-council, Hungarian Womens Democratic Federation, etc.)

DOBI participated in the leftist movements even before 1945. He is from Szony village, in the Trans-Danubian hill district, where there is an oil refinery. DOBI has been a simple day laborer, had a few acre^s land in the village, and next to agriculture he worked as journey laborer and earth worker. He already played a serious role at that time in the Peasant Federation and also in the Small Landowners Party.

After 1945 three parties competed for DOBI: the Small Landowners Party, the National Peasant Party and the Communist Party. He remained in the Small Landowners Party and on its ticket was elected as representative. However from the first moment Dobi enjoyed the confidence of the communists and he too was confident to them. In the Small Landowners Party Dobi has been ^{first} ~~first~~ member of the presidency and later, after the president's ~~dep~~ VARGA Bela's departure for America, Dobi became president of the party. He still has this position.

In the administration of the country DOBI filled many different positions, he has been minister of agriculture, and after DEMNYES Lajos he became prime minister and from this position came to the head of the Presidium Council.

(DARVAS Joseph, SZABO Zoltan, KOVACS Imre, TALPASI Tibor, etc.) Their writings had great effect all over the contry. Several of them were prosecuted by the courts of that time and received shorter or longer jail sentences. (Here in the first place KOVACS Imre should be mentioned, who lives now in America). ERDEI Ferenc published ^(books) 2-3 on the subject at that time.

He was connected ^{openly} with Hungarian politics first in October 1944 and became minister of interior in the first provisory Hungarian government. He has been agricultural, justice, etc. minister. Since 1945 he is a ^{true} satellite, and servant of the communists. The communists from the first moment considered the National Peasant Party as their allies and had had executed many uncomfortable affairs through the Peasant Party. ERDEI, DARVAS, and VERES Peter executed these jobs always without any hesitation.

During the fall of 1945 for a short time he was defense minister (secretary of state for defense) However at this post he proved in a few weeks that he is not up to this job. He received the task, with PETER Gabor and some other leaders to prepare for the civil war. The small landholders party and the bourgeois parties were very strong at that time. If they would have grabbed the power then the communist would have forced their own rule even with the provocation of a civil war. ~~REVAI~~ REVAI Joseph talked about this also. For this purpose the communists had secret arm depots (one in the cellar of the Atheneum press in the Miksa street, another in the cellar of the Gellert Hotel etc.) under FARKAS's supervision. At the same time he was the organizer and leader of the shore guard(at that time called as organizing guard). He was member of the parliament from the first moment. He was member of the highest party organization, the political committee, until 1955. For a long time he was active in the party as Rakosi's deputy. He became member of the government when the communists on Soviet instructions started the organization of the army. He became minister of defense and received from one hour to the

other the rank of colonel-general. He is the TITO-GOERING type man who creates his own uniform in which he resembles a decorated christmas tree. With the help of Soviet experts his name is connected with the creation of the Hungarian army.

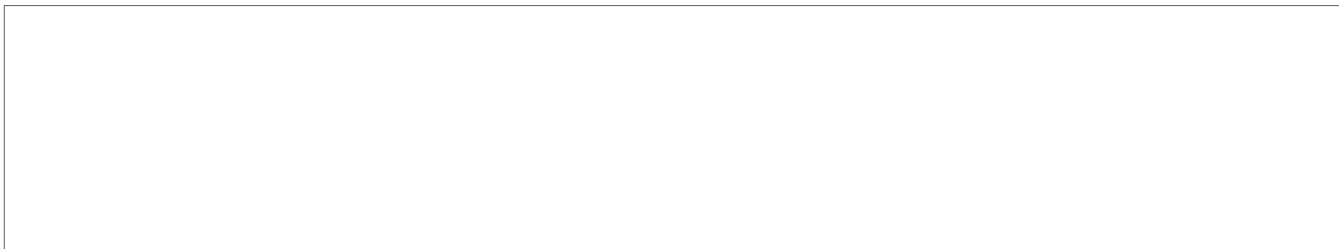

GELLERT is the first ~~son~~ of FOGARASI Bela, professor, the first ideologist of the Party of Hungarian Workers. GELLERT graduated from highschool and then with the help of FOGARASI has been employed by the Hungarian Radio as a newspaperman. On his uncle's prompting he joined the party. However in the party he has not performed any active work. FOGARASI had him sent out to Moscow and after a few weeks stay an altogether different GELLERT returned to Hungary. He buried himself in the party work, and studied marxism day and night. The former apolitical boy began to play politics. First he has been sent out ~~in the~~ by the Hungarian Radio to the Soviet Union for experiment exchange, and when he returned he became deputy section head, and later was sent to a six months term party shhool. At present he attends the highest party school. He finished the first two years with distinction as first of ~~the~~ his class. After graduation from this latter mentioned school GELLERT shall be again sent to the Soviet Union for a year of postgraduste work and then shall enter the Hungarian political life.



He is a well (smooth)

mannered, very sympathetic young man. He who a few years ago repeatedly stated that he should be left alone, he does not want to have anything to do with politics, today since his uncle FOGARASI introduced him to politics, says that Hungary shall belong for decades attached to the Soviet block. The West has no power to detach Hungary (from the Soviet block) and therefore the opportunity is open that he should fill a leading position here - for this it is worthwhile to study.

Despite the fact that he graduated from the highest party school, GELLERT is not biased. He reads Western papers and follows the events (with interest). He has a wife, they would like to have a child this year.

GELLERT, Andras.

He has been already told, that after the finishing of this school, the party shall place him in the party propaganda machinery. In his circle of friend everybody calls GELLERT already as, comrade minister. But, joking aside, in two three years time GELLERT shall be one of the directors of the communist propaganda machinery. GELLERT is a well intentioned, straight character man.

GERO, Ernő (Ernest)

This is not his real name. Allegedly he was SILBER or SILBERSTEIN and he is the son of the Rabbi of Ujpest. Ujpest is one of the suburbs of Budapest. He joined communism in ~~1918~~ 1919 and worked in the redaction of the "Red News" in the Visegradi street.

In the years between 1925-1930 some small communist cell was discovered and he was a member of this group. Allegedly he spent a year or a year and a half in jail which fact is very much publicized but I have not found any proofs ~~of this~~ concerning this.

Around 1930 he appeared in Moscow and lived there until 1944. During this time he learned the Russian language perfectly. In the meantime he was employed by the foreign language publishing concern of by the redaction of the Pravda. In the fall of 1944 he also returned to Hungary. From the beginning he acted as RAKOSI's deputy. They divided the work, that RAKOSI took care chiefly of the political matters and GERO played himself up into the role of ^{an} economic expert. The transformation of the Hungarian economic life into the communistic system was executed by GERO. For the today misery of the people GERO is responsible more than RAKOSI is. To raise his individual popularity the system proclaimed GERO as the motor of reconstruction, as the initiator of rebuilding, In 1945-47 the slogan came into being "Long live GERO the builder of bridges" However this seemed to be too much for RAKOSI, and Gero's popularity just disappeared from one day to the other.

His first disappointment came in 1946 during the Paris peace negotiations. America and the Western powers accepted the Soviet proposals for the border rectifications of the country. It was that about one millions of Hungarians will belong to us and not to Czechoslovakia and Rumania. For the support of the Hungarian point of view GERO went to Paris but there MOLOTOV and ~~his~~ his men practically ignored GERO. They had to publish in the Hungarian papers that Gero spends his vacation in France.

GERO is the planner of the three year plan through which my country took the road of planned economy. He made the five year plan also. Therefore he is responsible for the neglect of the Hungarian agriculture and the forced incomprehensible industrialization. His greatest sin is Stalin-varos (Stalin-city) and the Budapest subway plannings. This latter has cost inexpressible expenses to the Hungarian people. GERO was informed by experts that the Budapest subsoil is not suitable for subway building but GERO accepted the ~~groundless~~ ~~Soviet~~ groundless Soviet opinions and gave definite orders for the construction, which is at a standstill today. It cannot be realized because of the soil formation and constitution. Since 1945 GERO always filled important positions. First he was a member of the National Chief Council, later became minister and has this post since then. He has been minister of commerce, industry, commerce and transport, later transport and post, then second president of the ministers council, for a short time in the NAGY Imre era minister of interior and presently first deputy of the ministers council. He is the top economy man of the government. He always had to fight for this position in the party and even today he has to struggle with FRISS Istvan.

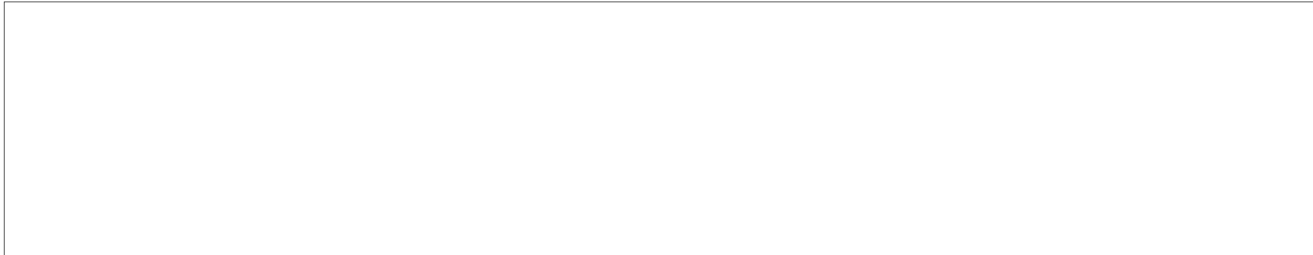

Later he was pensioned and complained that he cannot live on his pension. The party charged him with the proofreading of the "Társadalmi Szemle" (Sociological Bulletin) scientific magazine. He is still in this job. He is a broken man who is disillusioned in the whole communist idea.

At the university HARTAY got acquainted with communist and leftist ideas. He did some smaller and larger services to the student organisation^s that were under communist influence and they trusted him. Here he had to observe the rural paper^s as to whether they carry the country political directives properly. Here he actively participated in the party life and his prestige, power, and influence grew day by day. As the party started to grab the power Hartay also progressed. In 1948 he is already deputy head of the publicity (press-information) section of the ministry, and in 1950 he is the head of the press information bureau of the peoples education ministry. From this position with temporary mandate he became the head of the Radio. For years he has been the first man of the radio because BENKE Valeria has been put over him only in the summer of 1955.

A few times the communist leaders had conversation with HARUSTYAK and painted a rosy picture about his possible future successes if he is willing to co-operate. Soon, HARUSTYAK accepted the role of disintegrator. With communist help he was elected secretary of the chemical workers union and as such he could demand a place for himself in the leadership of the party. This he received and from this time on he became the leader of the leftist group (the fraction sympathizing with the communists). He has a great share in the annihilation of the party. When the workers party^{ies} merged in the Party of the Hungarian Workers, the communists pushed their man HARUSTYAK to the foreground. Here it has to be explained that the agreement between the two parties was made on parity basis and the jobs were partitioned between members of the two parties. However the communists when filling the posts allotted to the former social-democratic party, always tried to put in the positions those social-democrats who were communist sympathisers and so their men. This way HARUSTYAK also came in the fore. First he was made president of the Labor Unions of the Country, member of parliament and for a while even became member of the political Committee of the Party of the Hungarian Workers. However, slowly he was squized out of these positions and today he is only representative (MP) and member of the presidency of the SZOT (Labor Unions of the Country).

He has been in very close connection with RAKOSI from 1945 on. RAKOSI and his wife are the godparents of HAZI's children. At that time (1946-47) christening of children has not been prohibited yet, and great reports appeared in the Hungarian papers about the baptism.

The AEK (Allami Ellenorzesi Kozpont- State Control Central) ^{head, HAZI} made his name in-
famous because he ^{sent} very many honest people to jail as ones who unfaithfully handled state property. When RAKOSI needed a reliable minister of interior HAZI took over this post and has been a stronghanded man there also until the end. When he had to leave that post he went back to the head of the AEK and is still there, ^{however} ~~however~~ this central has become a ministry since.

A few months ago HAZI went to the limit when he called up the population of the country that every report of public interest (where socialist production is im-
peded) should be reported to him personally and he as minister and his deputies will receive personally the informers and even reward them with prizes. His name is also attached to the law for the creation of an office for the public interest denunciations. In plain Hungarian this means that if you do not like something denounce it. They will take care of him. This might be called ~~the~~ AVH on the economic line. All the shops, factories and enterprises are under his control, as a last forum.

Before and during the war he studied at the Budapest Technical university. According to my knowledge he never participated in the anti-German and anti-war activities of the university students. Today there are rumors in circulation about him that he was one of the organizers of the university leftist movements but this is mildly described a lie. Right away in 1945 he started to work on the communist line. However the party preferred SZALAY Bela in the front instead of HEGEDUS, [redacted] 25X1
He started to appear in the NEKOSZ the Peoples College Movement. [redacted]

of REVAI Joseph who introduced HEGEDUS to RAKOSI Matyas as an educated young man who is adaptable for any kind of work and is reliable from the point of view of the party.

During 1946 and 1947 at the university HEGEDUS accepted bigger parts in the interest of communist propaganda. From the university he went to the Central of the party [redacted] When the party needed new fa[redacted] 25X1
sons of the Hungarian soil, and not Moscovites and those of Jewish origin, Rakosi produced HEGEDUS. He was hardly 30 years old when he became minister. Previously he participated in various party schools and courses. He started his ministership by swearing allegiance to RAKOSI and showed himself as a completely true RAKOSI man. This was necessary by the simple reason because from the RAKOSI gang there was only GERO left the others were dropped, fell.

HEGEDUS , Andras (Andrew) -2-

RAKOSI wanted to surround himself with new, young men. His biggest promise was DONATH Ferefn who for a long time was the chief of his secretariat but ^{he} was in jail at that time, just released, so RAKOSI needed new men. HEGEDUS Andras and SZALAY Bela were discovered this way.

During his ministership HEGEDUS was a great believer and advocate of the kolkhozisation. With grim determination he started to learn Russian and in every disputed matter took RAKOSI's view. During the prime ministership of NAGY Imre as deputy ~~minister~~ president of the council of ministers he informed RAKOSI of every move NAGY Imre and GERO Erno made with the result that RAKOSI recommended him to the Soviet embassy and ^{to} Soviet leaders.

When evidence was needed against NAGY Imre -speeches,articles etc - HEGEDUS became the witness for the prosecution. The conclusion: first he became first deputy president of the council of ministers, then president of the council. [] he is the youngest prime minister of the world. In everything he is a tru follower of RAKOSI, and his disciple. His only rival is SZALAI Bela, feared by HEGEDUS. 25X1

In his youth he got acquainted with communist ideas. Soon he has been arrested and spent several years at the Margit Boulevard military prison. At the end of 1944 or at the beginning of 1945 he has been released and since then fills important roles in the party. At first he became the deputy manager of the "Szabad Nep"(Free People) the central paper of the party. At this time the paper has been managed by REVAI Joseph. When REVAI became minister, HORVATH took over the direction of the daily. He is also a member of the central management of the party. Since 1945 he is member of the parliament without interruption. HORVATH chiefly is interested in cultural problems and the writers fear him just as they did ~~from~~ ^{smart} REVAI. He is a very ~~smart~~ man in jockeying for a position. An example: During the prime ministership of NAGY Imre, the voice of the "Szabad Nep" became milder. When this policy has been discontinued(liquidated) the SZAbad Nep has been reproached also. Several men have been fired(PATKO Imre, MERAY Tihor, DAKI Terez, FEHER Lajos, deputy manager. etc.) but HORVATH Marton who directed the whole paper has been left at ~~his~~ job. He suffered no harm at all.

Another small picture to show his character: VADAS Gyula Dr., former editor of the defunct "Nemzeti Sport"(National Sport, sport paper(before 1945) used to live in his nice villa at No.37.Szemlohegyi street. HORVATH wanted to move in to this house and gave 24 hours to VADAS to move out. Next day AVH men appeared

and moved out VADAS's belongings. HORVATH sent the AVH men, and they took care of the moving and placed VADAS in an apartment in the Vorostorony street. HORVATH had to move to the VADAS place because he had acquaintances ^{living} in the neighborhood.

The actors and play wrights fear HORVATH. His late brother-in-law NOTI Karoly the well known comedy play wright looked at the world through the glasses of bourgeois complacency - HORVATH did not understand this attitude and attacked him publicly. His sister, NOTI's ~~reproached/his~~ wife reproached him saying "When you were in jail and we brought food for you then we were good enough for you but now that you are on the top nobody is good for you."

HORVATH is member of parliament since 1945. He is also a member of the Central Party Management. There was time when Horvath was the director of the propaganda, ~~section~~ cultural and art-section of the Central Management.

JANOSI, Ferenc, former deputy minister, son-in-law of NAGY Imre, president of the council of ministers.

JANOSI's carrier has been formed very interestingly. He is from Vasarosnameny (or from the close vicinity), graduated from highschool there, went to Debrecen to the Reformed church theological college, and became reformed priest(Calvinist). As a young preacher he returned to the region where he was brought up and soon was connected with politics, and participated in the back ground activities. He sympathized very strongly with nazism. During the second world war he voluntarily reported for military service. ~~and during this~~ As a military chaplain he was still strongly a friend of the nazis. He was sent to the Russian front and there quickly observed the barbarous cruelties of the nazis and the Hungarian arrow soldiers. As he related "My eyes opened soon and I saw that we are fighting for injustice." At the front he has seeked the friendship of simple Hungarian decently thinking soldiers, and when he was convinced that the Germans have lost the war he has searched for connections toward the partizans. He soon found it. He has set free two-three sentenced partizans in secret before their execution. Later he has built up closer connections and even has obtained arms for them. His behavior was suspicious to his fellow officers but no proof could be found against him. One day the walking priest has been captured by a partizan group who took him to a forest for execution. With great difficulty he had himself understood that he has helped another parizan group for months. This has been proved and JANOSI went over to this group and for a while participated in the partizan fights against the Germans and the Hungarians and later he was sent to Moscow. Here he had long conversations with the leaders of the communists ~~leaders~~ living in exile. He was sent to political schools and it is a fact that at the end of 1944 JANOSI returned to Hungary as one of the founders of the new Hungarian democratic army. At this time he had colonel's

rank. He got acquainted with the daughter of NAGY Imre, whom he soon married. For years he served in the ministry of defense, as a colonel, enjoying the complete confidence of the Russians. From here he was transferred to the ministry of Peoples Education as deputy minister. This happened when LOSONCZI Geza was arrested. When DARVAS became minister, JANOSI was already first deputy minister and in fact he was the minister. In this position he completely served (satisfied) the Soviet requirements. When his father-in-law NAGY Imre became president of the council of ministers, in 1953, JANOSI left the ministry of peoples education, became head of the secretariat of the council of ministers.

JANOSI had a very great power in this position. In the meantime when the National Peoples Front was revived the post of general secretary was filled with Janosi also. When NAGY Imre became ill and his position became shattered, Janosi's standing turned out to be shaky also. When NAGY Imre left his post JANOSI has been relieved from his position as head of the secretariat of the council of ministers. He has been also discharged of his post as ^{general} secretary of the National Peoples Front organisation.

For a few weeks JANOSI loafed around without any jobs, however he received his salary as a deputy minister. Later he was nominated as director of the Jozsef Attila and Petofi museums. This is a honorary position without any power. In November 1955 he still filled this position.

His wife speaks a very good Russian and has worked at the editorial offices of the "Vengrija" a Russian language magazine published in Hungary. They live together with the NAGY Imres in a villa.

A new change has been observed in JANOSI's when he was deprived of all of his positions. For instance he was prepared that he will be arrested. He proclaimed that his father-in-law could not be arrested because he always acted with the full knowledge of the party. As long as JANOSI had his position as deputy minister

From here he has been transferred with secretary of state rank in the information ministry of that time, and later, after filling various important political positions, he became minister of foreign affairs. KALLAI, as minister of foreign affairs, has been detained. He has been charged that he urged the discontinuation of the party way back in 1944 and urged the formation of the Peace Party. This is all true, and is a fact, however KALLAI acted on instruction from Moscow. For this crime he spent close to two years in jail, and was released only about a year ago. After a few weeks recuperation he received his membership card, became full right party member and was placed at the peoples education ministry as deputy minister. At present his jurisdiction covers the book publishing, the supervision of folks art and its direction. His life has been very varied and also tragic. One part of his schooling has been at Berettyoujfalu, where his parents were small artisans. Later he went to Debrecen, where he connected the "March Front" progressive youth movement and became one of the leaders. From Debrecen he went to Budapest, was employed at editorial offices of the "Nepszava"(The Peoples Voice). In 1942 he is already

political editor of the social-democratic paper, however at this time he was already known as one of the leaders of the illegal communist party. After the 19 of March 1944, he also had to go underground. He emerged in 1945, but in the meantime naturally he actively participated in the underground work. He also, has been present at the negotiations conducted with governor Horthy, with the subject that the Hungarian workers should be armed (be supplied with arms) against the Nazis. In 1943 or in 1944 he published a book of great interest about the Hungarian poet Petofi. In 1945 it was revealed that he was not the author of this book, it was written by REVAI Joseph in Moscow and arrived to Hungary through a round about channel and printed and published at Budapest under KALLAI's name.

After 1945 his parents received a house as a gift at Bekasmegyér, a former Swabian (German) house. They received the home of an expropriated German family. However, one night the old KALLAI couple have been murdered with ax by unknown persons who have not been found even today. KALLAI married a young sculptress whom he courted already in 1943. While KALLAI has been in prison the wife divorced him and connected her life with someone else. When KALLAI has been rehabilitated and released from prison by the communists, he had no one (to turn to). For a few days he was sheltered at his former secretary. When he became deputy minister he received first a furnished apartment at the Székely Bertalan street and then later a villa on the Szabadság hill. Today he lives there.

KALLAI is an individual of tragical fate. He believed in communism from his younger days and had to be disappointed in this belief the most. For this ~~his~~ faith he lost his parents, his love deserted him while he was in prison (he got acquainted with his wife during the party work). When he has been released from prison his speech has been -understandably- very reserved. It could be observed on his every move, the fear from and the aversion toward the cause. All that he said was that

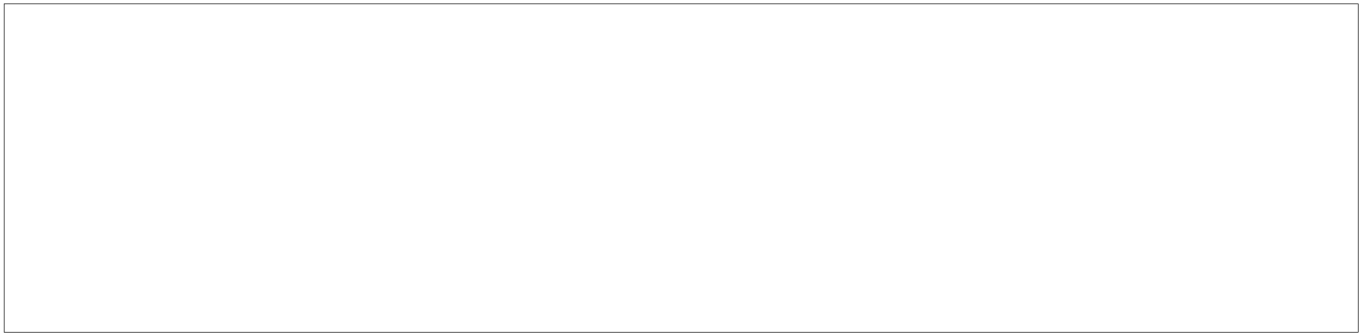

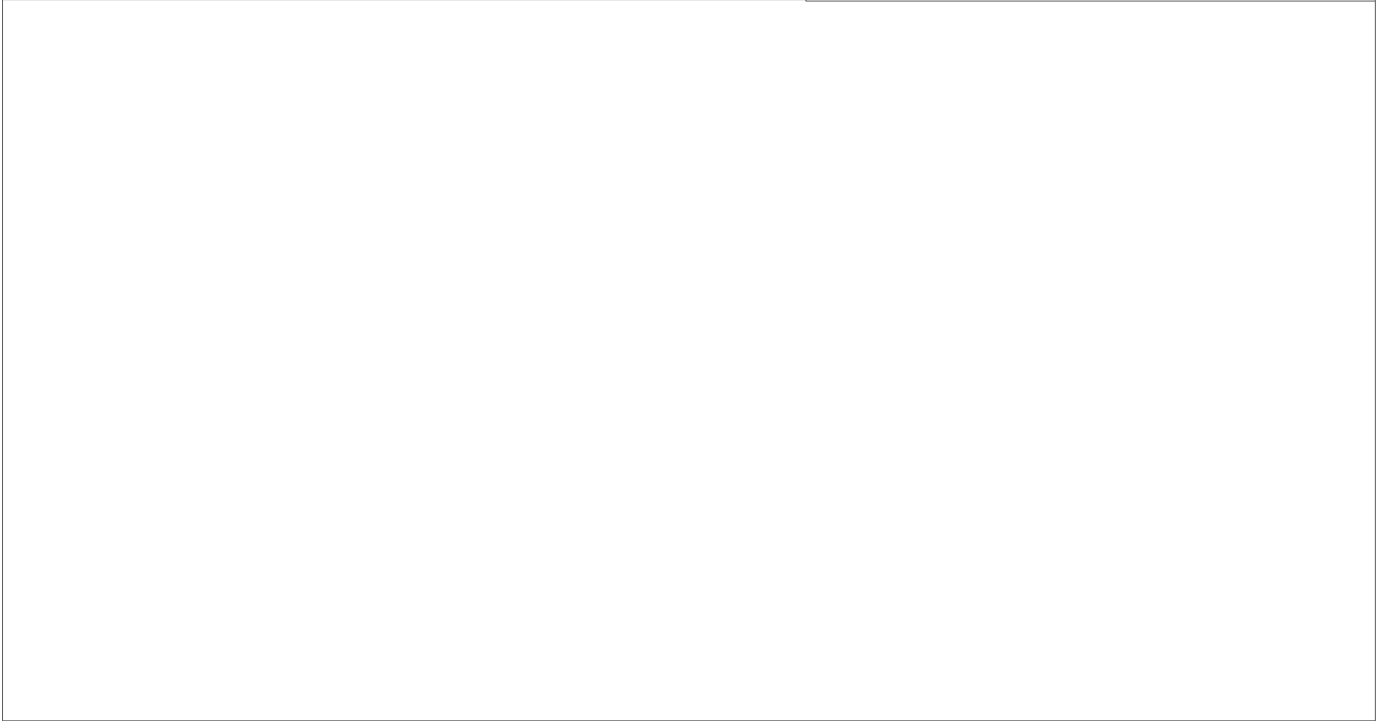

It is true that at this time it was very difficult to find jobs. Maybe this was the reason that he accepted a job with the street car company after his schooling.

There he got acquainted with socialist ideas, then went a step further and belonged to the left wing, organized several strikes and became a member of illegally operating communist party.

He was among the first that were sent to the Soviet front as labor service. At that time in Hungary those of leftist sentiments were collected in labor camps and sent to the Soviet front where they perished by the hundreds. This is the way KOSSA reached the front line, he participated in the DON retreat and with difficulty succeeded to become a prisoner of the Russians. When he identified himself here he was immediately picked out, sent for a few weeks rest and then to school and later followed the Soviet army and as political agitator was active in the Hungarian villages and towns, in 1944 and 1945 until the end of the war..

After the end of the war KOSSA was delegated by the communists to the labor unions and worked as president or secretary of the labor unions. Later became the first vice president of the first assembly. In the labor union he received the task to annihilate the social-democratic opposition and this task he accomplished with difficulty. VAS Miklos the leader of the social-democratic labor union was sent to jail by KOSSA, who could not tackle him in any other way.

The party transferred KOSSA right and left. In the first years he was the object of many attacks. The reason of these attacks ^Iwas that when he arrived at Budapest in 1945 he received clothes, furniture, etc. from the Government Commission of the abandoned goods. He received some shirts that were recognized by the former owner, a Jew who came home, and for this KOSSA was attacked even in the parliament as one who plundered Jewish properties. After he was relieved ^{from} the labor union job he became deputy minister, later minister for finances and still later he was president of the Man Power Reserve Office, then first deputy president of the Planning Office, then head of the State-Church affairs Office and before that he was president of the OMB the Wage Regulation Board.

First he enjoyed great respect in the party machine but this fame slowly faded away and today he is only auxiliary member of the Central Committee and member of the parliament.

The wife of KOSSA Istvan had to work hard ^(during the Horthy times) to keep their two daughters because the husband did not earn much.

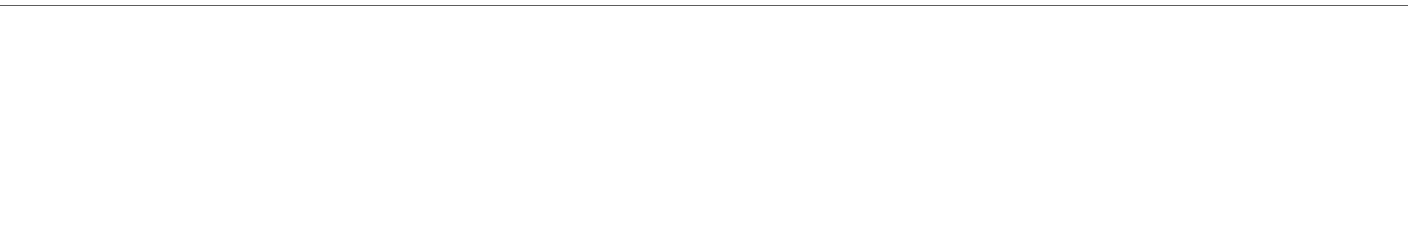

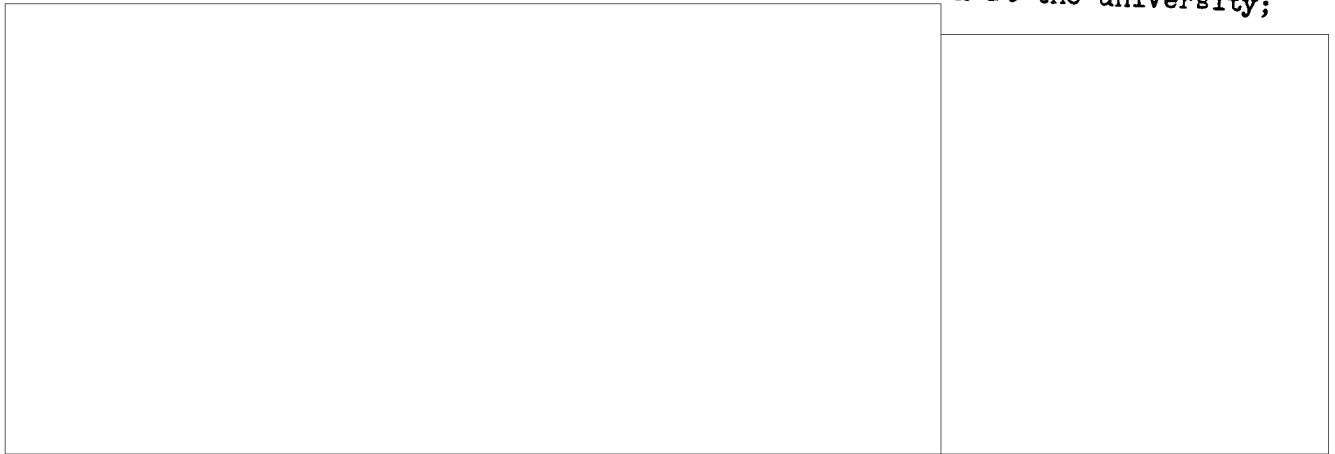

The chief editor of the paper sent him to America at the end of the 1930-ies, where he spent one or one and a half years. In 1940 he is already the reader-editor of the "Az Est". From this time on he is more and more connected with politics and already in 1943 he is collaborating with BAJCSY-ZSILINSZKY Endre, the great martyr of the Hungarian struggle for liberty. At this time MIHALYFI is the chief editor of the "Fuggetlen Magyarország"(Independent Hungary) the newspaper of BAJCSY*ZSILINSZKY Endre (the paper appeared once a week on Mondays). At this time he joined the bourgeois section of the small landholders party. On the 19 of March 1944, when Hitler invaded Hungary, MIHALYFI had to go into illegality (underground) and he lived this way until January 1945. In 1945 he began to be active in the small landholders party but at the first election he was not even nominated as a candidate. At this time he is the editor, responsible for the paper, of the "Vilag" liberal daily and editor in chief of the "Fuggetlen Magyarország" Monday weekly paper. However he yearns for a political carrier(position). He connects himself to TILDY Zoltan, and becomes his faithful satellite, quasi his chief of publicity. When TILDY becomes prime minister, MIHALYFI through some irregularities becomes a member of the parliament. Here from the first moment he belongs to the communist sympathizers and in the small landholders party he is ^{one of} the leader^s of the "left wing liberal group".

At this time he also participated in the highest direction of the small landholders party. MIHALYFI as head of the presidential office enjoyed the confidence of TILDY, state president, who initiated him into his innermost thoughts. MIHALYFI communicated these thoughts with the communist leaders and in the first place with RAKOSI and REVAI.

TILDY's son in law CSORNOKY Victor was conciller of legation at Washington and later minister and envoy in Cairo. This matter became urgent because KOVACS Bela general secretary of the party (small landholders) has been arrested by the Russians. Here it has to be mentioned that the ^{mass of the} so-called compromising evidence against KOVACS was furnished by MIHALYFI Erno. When MIHALYFI learned the plan that CSORNOKY prepared, he communicated ^{it} with RAKOSI. RAKOSI ran to the Russians and the matter was taken over by the Russian NKDW. Two NKDW men, disguised as American officers, connected CSORNOKI at Cairo and agreed that they will take TILDY to Vienna where he will be placed under American protection. The password in Vienna would have been "towe" (toe of the foot). When the two pseudo-Americans talked over everything with Csornoki, CSORNOKI was called back to Budapest for report-making (consultation). CSORNOKI got suspicious and called the presidential office long distance and asked what he should do. MIHALYFI answered the call and told CSORNOKI to come home urgently because there are matters to be talked over. CSORNOKI arrived at Budapest but did not have a chance to talk to TILDY, he had to go to the foreign ministry where MOLNAR Erik foreign minister already waited for him, they talked for two-three minutes and CSORNOKI left. In the ante-room

VARADY, Gyorgy , major and four AVH men waited for him and took him in custody. PETER, Gabor, the head of the AVH informed TILDY in a letter that his son-in-law OSORNOKI has been taken in custody for treason. TILDY ran to RAKOSI, who presented him with the evidences. TILDY was told that he can save his skin, they will let him run but he has to resign. TILDY asked for a few hours to make up his mind then addressed his letter of resignation to NAGY Imre, president of the assembly at that time. For the resignation the communists guaranteed the personal safety of TILDY, and he also received a villa where he is still living in house custody(arrest) with his family.

His smaller sin, that he participated in the clean-up of the party demanded by the communists and in the removal of the so-called reactionary elements. When DOBÉ Istvan became president of the party and prime minister, MIHALYFI had already a ^{deciding} voice in the party. 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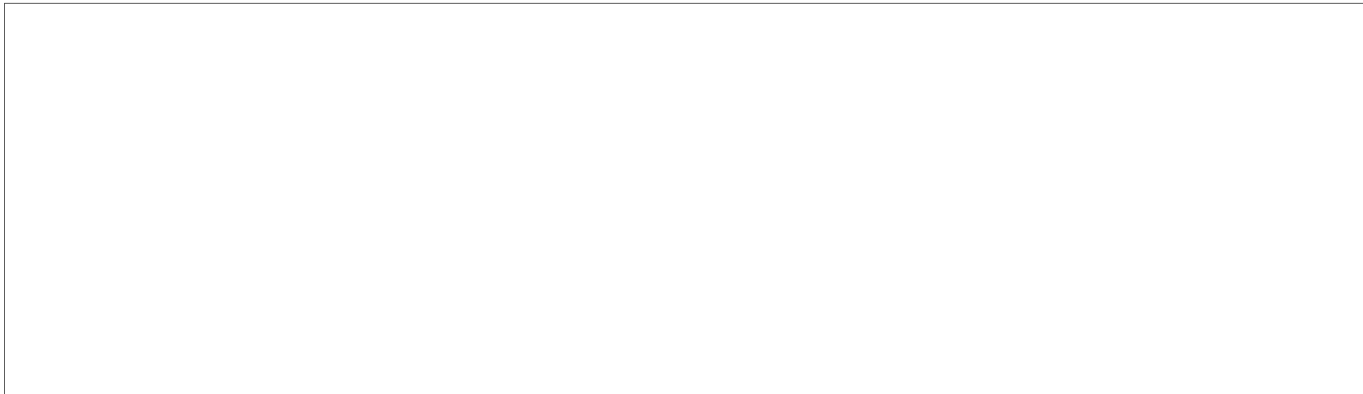

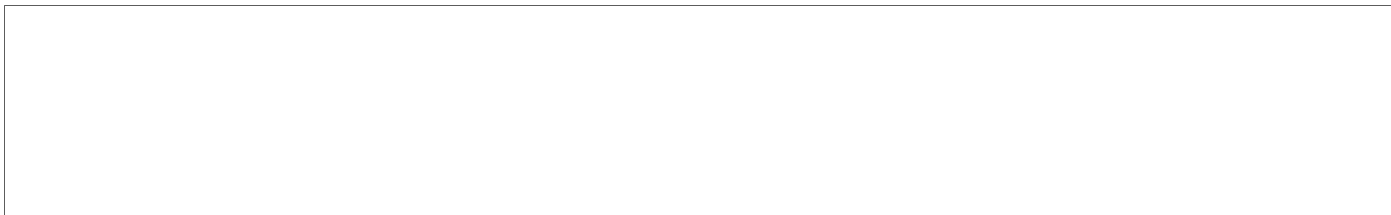

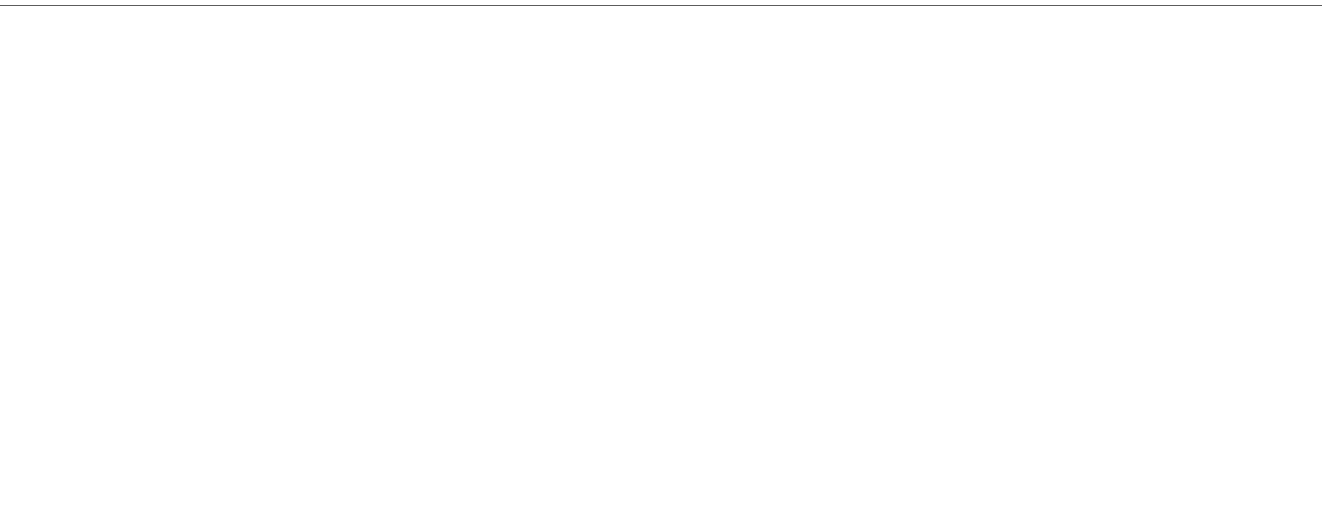

His name became known in 1945 as the minister of land distribution. It is interesting to note that the communists dealt the role to NAGY Imre already at that time which was very useful later to reach their goals,

[redacted] NAGY Imre as the minister of land distribution 25X1
enjoyed a certain popularity, and when the communist later needed a man - at the beginning of the NEP era - who was not too well known and hated, NAGY was presented to the people. The communists reached their goal perfectly because during NAGY premiership the people breathed more freely and the hidden small values and material goods came out of the caches and were invested in private enterprises just to be taken away from them later by the communists, a few months later.

[redacted] He connected the party in 1919. He was president 25X1
of the SOMogy county directorium, or a member of it. At this time the mentioned directorium convicted a great number of innocent people and had them executed. After the fall of communism, NAGY somehow reached Moscow,

[redacted] stayed there until 1944, when he came back 25X1
to Hungary.

In December 1944 when in Moscow the first provisory Hungarian government was formed, NAGY was the first man who was presented to the Hungarian politicians and civic leaders. (DALNOKI-MIKLOS Bela, general, TELEKI Geza, count, politician, SZENTIVANYI Dominic, former press chief of the presidency, former diplomat.)

[redacted] NAGY's name became known in 1945 with the distribution 25X1
of land. In this period of popularisation he was known as the "Land distributor". After a short time as agricultural minister he became the second minister of interior, but stayed in this position a very short time. His name is connected with the forming of the police and so naturally the forming of the since then famous political police. After the first election the communists insisted

keeping the ministry of interior in their hands, which during the provisory government was held by the peasant party's ERDEI Feszenc. The communists knew that the only armed force in the country was the police and who that controls the police controls the country. For this post they needed a strong man and put NAGY Imre to the place as reliable. NAGY could not stand his ground and was relieved by RAKJ Ladislas.

From this time on he did not fill any important position in the Hungarian political life. he received a professorship at the agrar-scientific university. He was member of the Central Committee to the end also of parliament and ^{of the} political committee which is the biggest factor in the communist party. Of this committee he became a member only during his premiership.

As prime minister he executed ~~was~~ what the party wanted from him, what the party ordered. It might have been some slighter deviations from the prescribed road but he could not commit capital sins. When he became prime minister he made a speech about the private initiatives, civil rights, etc, which had a great reaction in the whole country. If not all but some of these promises were realized. Internation camps were discontinued(dissolved) great number of interned persons were freed, individual initiative encouraged etc. Another great achievement during NagY Imre's time, the creation of the new POpular Front. The importance of this movement that in this great social organisation everybody could and should participate who was against the war. Party membership was not important in fact it was accentuated that in the first place non party members were preferred.

The difference between RAKOSI and NAGY started during the latter's premiership. NAYG's speech as mentioned above and in which he stated that the kulak is also a human being had great reaction throughout the country. The reaction

was so great that the party got scared and after ten days RAKOSI made a corrective speech in which he rectified many parts of the NAGY speech. The address was not written by NAGY Imre but he received it from the party to be delivered at the parliament. Therefore the main point of the accusation that he took an independent road, was untrue. Every speech that is delivered in the Hungarian parliament is written down previously and presented to the party secretariat, the same system is used for newspaper articles. NAGY Imre became popular. If anybody else would have been in his place the situation would have been the same. Somehow the Hungarian people saw that NAGY Imre dropped a straw in the sea of bitterness and the people tried to grab this straw to lengthen its life. Some ~~people~~ people who were jailed for party offenses were freed at this time. (KADAR Janos, RAKOSI's former deputy and minister of interior, HARASZTHY Sandor, LOSONCI Geza, KALLAI Gyula former minister, etc.). NAGY Imre trusted the secretary of the council of ministers ~~to his~~ which is the greatest helping organ of the prime minister- to his brother in law JANOSI Ferenc who formerly was the first deputy minister of People's education. When his position was shaken his brother in law was also transferred -according to good communist principles [redacted] he is today the director of the JOZSEF Attila and PETOFI museums. His daughter, who worked at the "Vengrija" Russian language newspaper, before the father became prime minister, was fired from the paper, later reemployed, and then again dismissed. [redacted] When the NEP era 25X1 reached its end, NAGY did everything that was expected of him: he lured the hidden capital out of its hiding places, rehabilitated the great process that started from many political errors. NAGY Imre performed his role and had to be relieved. As a lucky coincidence he became sick. This was confirmed by many leading Hungarian politicians including DOBI Istvan president, and

is not a story made up, or an invented sickness.

RAKOSI having seen the great popularity of Nagy wanted to silence him for good, and therefore he brought up the question of confidence, he demanded selfcriticism from NAGY. NAGY flatly refused.

NAGY stated repeatedly that they should talk over the matter after he gets well again. When NAGY Imre left the party hospital of Kutvolgyi street, the matter of selfcriticism came up again. NAGY refused. RAKOSI would liked to summon NAGY before the court. NAGY answered that yes he is willing but "all of us should sit together on the bench of the accused because you and GERO pushed the country into bankruptcy." This all is the information of DOBI Istvan. Then RAKOSI summoned the Central Committee together ⁱⁿ ~~with~~ the firm belief that they will brand NAGY Imre. However it did not happen so. They, (the Central Committee) did not want to exclude Nagy even from the political committee. In the meantime RAKOSI was so certain in his measures that he already ordered the placing NAGY Imre and his family in security. The KV (Central committee) did not consent to this and RAKOSI and GERO ~~left~~ flew to Moscow where they received the instructions that "this is a Hungarian matter and should be taken care of ~~in~~ your own authority". A new Central Committee meeting followed, on which it had been resolved to deprive NAGY Imre of all his offices. In the meantime NAGY was summoned to Moscow, but with whom he negotiated, what he accomplished, are unknown to me. The fact is that his car was given back that before was taken away from him, his daughter was given back her job, and NAGY receives his university rector pension~~s~~.

The news were spread on the West that when NAGY appears on the street the people cheer for him and celebrate him - these rumors are not true. What the Free Europe Radio stated concerning this is similarly untrue. The fact is,

During the II world war ~~was~~ NEMETH actively participated in anti-war propaganda work. From 1945 he was political editor of the "Vilag" (Worl) until the cessation of the paper in 1949. Since then NEMETH had ^{small} temporary jobs, At present he is working at the composition of an explanatory dictionary for the Hungarian Academy of sciences, receives 600 Forints per month, and besides contributes articles to various papers.

He is decidedly Friendly toward America. To this it has to be added that he had a very good friend Mr. Luiss REWEY, who, lived at Budapest and befriended him at the Eotvos College(a fraternity). REWEY studied there for a few years and after 1945 became press attache of the American Legation. NEMETH recommended to REWEY " If you want to make effective propaganda then you should help out (to get out of the country) a newspaperman or similar individual every three months or half a year and then your radio shall have permanently fresh, new material, and the public will believe you."

RAKOSI was very vain (and proud) that he helped with his "smile" but it is ^{to} NONN's credit that since that time every application is investigated. First he was deputy minister, and later first deputy of the minister. In this position he in fact had more power than the minister who did not belong to the communist party.

[REDACTED] NONN has been already nominated to his new post as attorney general of the country. NONN is no university graduate unless he graduated in the meantime. According to every probability he has been named to this position, because a true RAKOSI man was necessary there and NONN certainly is one, he knows RAKOSI's customs [REDACTED] NONN's predecessor has not been a jurist,

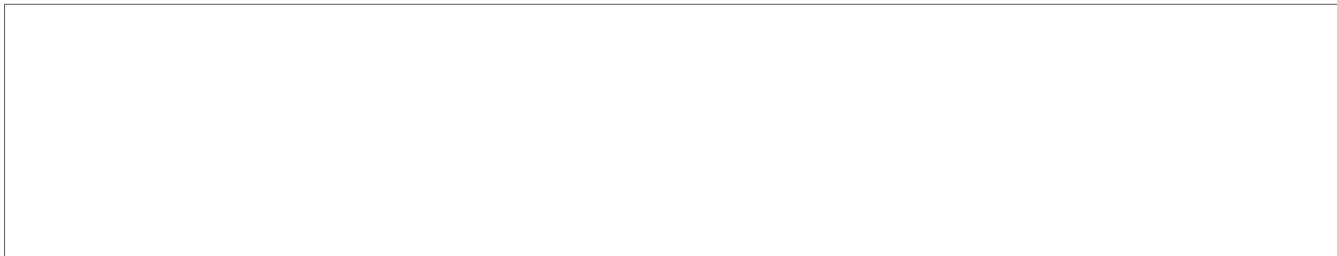

His name became famous because since 1943 he wrote the shappest anti-nazi articles in Hungary. At this time as a left side newspaperman he was very populer in Hungary.

and to England. On the 19th of March 1944 when the Germans occupied Hungary, PARRAGI Gyorgy was one of the first whom the Germans arrested. The Germans treated him humanly but the Hungarian nazis, the arrow party members tortured him badly. The Germans deported him together with several Hungarian politicians to Mauthausen and he was kept there until the spring of 1945. At this time he returned to Hungary and recovered physically soon, and worked with the press and also started to play a role in politics. He became editorial writer of the "Magyar Nemzet" and on the small landholder party platform he was elected to parliament. At the assembly he made several anti-communist speeches and also in the press he wrote the most anti-Soviet and anti-communist articles. Upon the recommendation of NAGY Ferencc the former prime minister-who lives now in America* he was expelled from the party. The communists demanded this. Everybody waited that he will be arrested for the shapp anti-Soviet articles. The predecessor of the AVH, the political police kept after him for weeks. Then RAKOSI summoned him, showed him the warrant for his arrest,

and explained to him that for his speeches and articles he might draw a death sentence. ~~PARRAGI~~ All this could be avoided -supposedly RAKOSI said- if PARRAGI would be willing to help to win over the bourgeoisie. PARRAGI accepted. He gradually started to serve the communist cause. First he became deputy leader and later - after Balogh Istvan has been discarded - leader of the Balogh party. PARRAGI is still member of the parliament, member of the Presidium Council and editor in chief of the "Magyar Nemzet" daily. For years now the communists have PARRAGI in their hands and he is completely laid low to them.

He would like very much to make a political carrier and in this interest is searching for the good will and friendship of every influential people. Also, he would like to travel. He has never been in the West. At one occasion he has been in Czechoslovakia. Materially he has a balanced life. His income reaches 4000 forints.

When the councils had to be popularized in the Radio, upon party instruction PERLAY prepared the programs. He condemned the NACY Imre era event~~y~~ at the beginning and therefore had some smaller friction with people, however when the era ended PERLAY's prestige understandably grew high.

He studied for a year at the Budapest university and then went to the Soviet Union, he spent three years there and studied at some university(not in Moscow) in some city. When he returned to Hungary immediately he was placed at the management of the DISZ and came to the paper., first as editorial page editor and later as member of the editorial board. Today he is still in this position. His colleagues say about him~~that~~ that he wants to solve everything with Soviet methods and only regards as good what he learned there.

PINTER is an extreme communist who accepts the party resolutions as the holy scripture. His collaborators say that he spends his time to write reports to the party center and to the Soviet Embassy about the situation at the paper.

He is the individual who openly professes that a good newspaperman can be only a party member who besides takes his fullsize part in the party work also. If there is a campaign-like task to be solved then PINTER is in the first line.

He criticizes everything he believes that is not party-attitude but he himself does not tolerate criticism.

PIROS, Laszlo

Minister of interior, head of the AVH.

PIROS participated in the workers movements already before 1945, but has not had much role there. His original trade is hog butcher and butcher. After 1945 he immediately received an important post in the labor union. However, he has been active only a few months when he was sent to schooling. He is a communist party representative in the parliament from the first. For a while he served in the party central and then before the turn, or right after (1948) he has been sent first to a six months course, and then ^{for} ~~to a~~ one year ^{to a} higher party school. After graduation from these schools he has been sent from one important post to the other. First he became deputy secretary general of the SZOT (Szakszervezetek Országos Tanácsa) Country Council of the Labor Unions). From here unexpectedly he has been commandeered to the AVH. by the party and there with generals rank he became deputy of PETER Gabor. At this time he moved from his apartment at the Thek Endre street, and at the Leonardo da Vinci street to a villa at Buda.

When he has been transferred to the AVH, there were rumors circulating that the party wanted to fill the AVH with workers cadres (cadres). Years later it was revealed that PIROS received the role to watch PETER Gabor and in proper time take steps to make him harmless with Russian help.

When PETER Gabor has been arrested PIROS became the head of the AVH, and he directed the AVH. work. Soon he has been named deputy minister for the interior, the first deputy minister and now for more than a year he is minister for the interior and at the same time head of the AVH. When at the first time he has been the head of

the AVH., the AVH belonged ~~to~~ jurisdictionally under the council of ministers and not under the minister of interior. When PIROS became minister of interior the direction and supervision over the AVH was transferred again into the minister of interiors hands.

PIROS ran a very great ~~and~~ carrier in the party in a few years. In 1945 he was only a representative in the parliament, then became auxiliary member of the party management and at present he is already an auxiliary member of the political committee.

[redacted] the AVH is not directed directly by him now. He created a new leader group a good many members of which group came from Moscow and the other members received Moscow training. These are PIROS's puppets. In the ministry of interior the police matters are taken care of by POCZE Tihor and GYORE Joseph deputy ministers.

During PIROS's ministership the working hours have been also changed at the AVH. PIROS prohibited for anybody to work more than eight hours and if that was still necessary then the overtime had to be taken out in free days.

[REDACTED] GERO raised charges against PIROS because as general secretary of the party he did not follow always the proper tactics of communism. RAKOSI completely took sides with PIROS in his defense.

Shortly it could be stated that PIROS is / completely a RAKOSI man. He attacked GERO only because he offended him and PIROS knew that at that time GERO attacked RAKOSI.

Personally I do not know him at all. For a while ^(CSAKI Sandor) ~~he~~ has been adjutant to him.

From CSAKI I know a few things about him.

He is a member of the party. There was a time when he has been the head of the country police. He only has the police under his authority, not the AVH.

He is a great sport fan. This, I can prove with examples. DEAK Ferenc, former soccer palyer, member of the national select team, who has been also a police first lieutenant, was caught in the act of ^(selling smuggled merchandise) ~~smuggling~~ (nylon things) and a

process was started against him. Friends turned to POCZE, who smoothed the affair.

The soccer players turn to him for smaller and larger favors. Generally he

helps sporting people. He also has been a worker.

PRIESZOL, Joseph, first deputy of the Post and transportation minister.

PRIESZOL is from Veszprem county, where he worked before 1945 in several mines as a miner. At this time he attracted attention ~~as~~ with his ability as agitator. At the election of 1945 he was not nominated by the social-democrats as a candidate, left the party and became a communist. At this time the communists received every newcomer gladly, especially men with clear past and workers background. On the communist list PRIESZOL was elected. After this he filled various post in different parts of the country, and in 1948 or 1949 he was sent to a higher school of the party for a year. After finishing his studies he was placed in the ministry of Posts and Transport as deputy minister.

Original family name ROTH. Comes from middle class merchant family. Studied high school at Szabadka and Sopron. Five or six brothers or sisters. As a young man participated in the first world war and there got acquainted with communist ideology.

After graduating from high school received government scholarship to Germany and England. He speaks these two languages well. During the first revolution - in 1919 - he hardly had a role at all. First he worked at the official newspaper of the party the "Red News". In the last weeks of the revolution his irresponsible lust for power caused the death of thousands (the battle of Salgotarjan). According to contemporaries, at this time, no particular talents of his could be discovered. For a few weeks he was deputy peoples commissar.

After the defeat of the revolution Rakosi had to escape, he went to the Soviet Union. There he attended various schools. Stalin and his company silenced the first line guard of the 1919 Hungarian revolution one by one (Bela KUN and his companions) and there was practically no one left of the old guard, who could be accepted by Moscow. Only Jeno LANDLER was accepted. This way the prestige of the young RAKOSI grew and grew. He started to play a role in the international communist movement. Right away he became an adherent of ~~the~~ Stalin and his line.

When the so-called white terror in Hungary (Horthy terror) faded away, Moscow issued the order that the Hungarian communist party should be called to life, be organised underground and if possible bring out in the open.

Rakosi was charged with this work. He received the task to go to Hungary and there organise the party in some form.

Why was RAKOSI adaptable for this role?

Because he had a large ^{or} circle of acquaintances. Before ~~on~~ during the first world war Rakosi was one of the leaders of the Galilei Club a progressive organisation of university students with whom at that time RAKOSI had contacts. When he went back to Hungary these former members were mostly in serious responsible positions. RAKOSI expected the help of his former club mates but was disillusioned by them. From the former friends nobody paid attention to him. (Rakosi's dislike of the Galilei Club originated at this time. When in 1945 RAKOSI attended the first meeting and there made a speech with the effect that in a few weeks the club discontinued its activity. Rakosi mentioned the above events there.) Another reason of his return to Hungary was that he knew if he will succeed in reviving the party in Hungary that will ~~have~~ have such an effect in Moscow that from one day to the other he will be the leader of Hungarian communists. He did not make a mistake in this calculation. 25X1

Rakosi started the work in Hungary with his young friend ^{Zoltan} ~~Zoltan~~ VASS (Weinberger) After short stay at Budapest RAKOSI was arrested by the political police. ~~His~~ Un-official opinion is that the arrest was helped by Moscow knowing that martyrdom raises their numbers. They calculated thus; if RAKOSI becomes a martyr the party will have more sympathizers. Whether RAKOSI is destroyed or not in the struggle ~~xxxxxx~~ the party will have full value of his person. When RAKOSI was released from prison and returned to Moscow, the former leaders of the Hungarian group MADZGAR Joseph, RUDAS Ladislas, were pushed in the background and RAKOSI became together the leader ~~with the~~ Zoltan VASS, who also emerged from the dusk of the unknowns. This was the way RAKOSI founded his future. When he became a martyr he could not be discarded anymore and demanded greater and greater place and position for himself in the communist oligarchy. Another of the ^{personality} ~~xxxxxx~~ characteristic trait ~~xxxxxx~~ RAKOSI ~~xxxxxx~~ ~~xxxxxx~~; when in jail, where he was convicted by the Horthy court, RAKOSI organized a ⁿ huger strike with

some fellow prisoners. Even here there was providence that he shall not become a martyr - GOGOS Ignatius and LOWY Sandor perished through this hunger strike - but RAKOSI came out unharmed. With regard to his state of health he only observed a "50 percent strike" he ate once a day, but the fellow strikers did not eat or drink for 8-10 days.

TELEKI Paul was Hungary's prime minister when RAKOSI Matyas was freed from the Szeged jail. The Soviet Union made an agreement with the Hungarian government that after RAKOSI's release regular commercial relations will be resumed and the ~~the~~ 1848 revolution flags will be ^{restored} restored to Hungary. These flags were in a Soviet war museum. It is interesting that at this time the public sentiment was very anti-communist in Hungary. Rakosi and his helpers could not revive the communist party in the years of the 1930-s. Instead they organised a socialist character party but this had no ground and no strenght. The experiment was discontinued.

The Soviet union saved RAKO-SI and VASS from the jail for tactical reasons, it was necessary to show the world that ~~the~~ Moscow saves its adherents and is even willing to make sacrifices for them. Resuming trade relations with Hungary was important for the Soviet in the first place to provide the material need of the slowly reviving party.

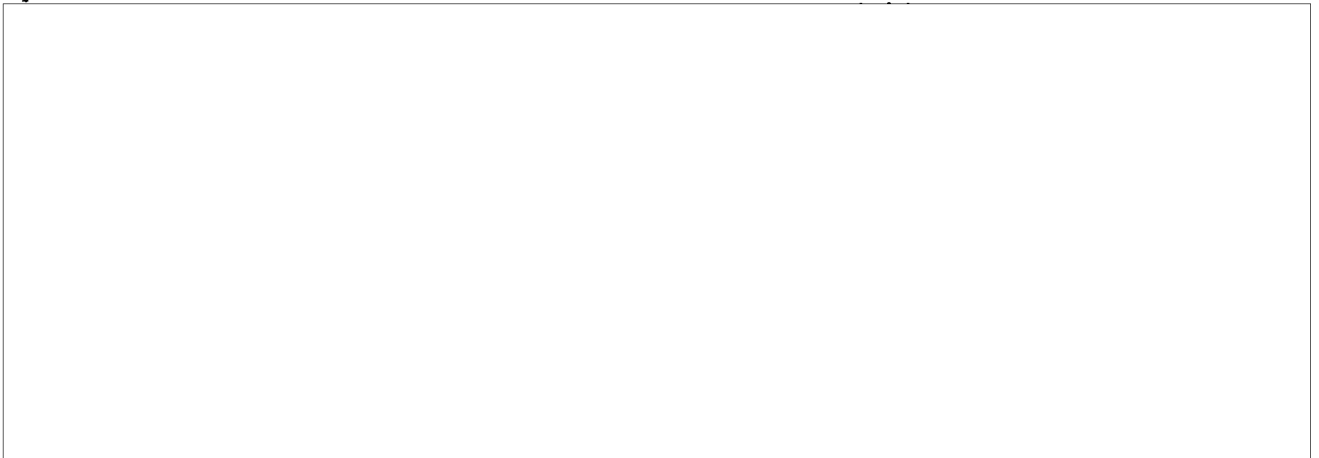
According to well informed Hungarian politicians Rakosi's release was suggested by German politicians and allegedly ERMANDDORF former German envoy at Budapest played the intermediary role.

When Rakosi has been released, he went right away to the Soviet legation at Budapest, spent a short time there and later was taken by Hungarian police officers and Soviet diplomats to Lavočne where the Hungarian police gave him over to the Soviets. He and Zoltan VASS were taken to Moscow and a great festival was started. The slogan of that day, that Moscow does not abandon its true sons.

Around this time RAKOSI got married. He married a Khazak origin Soviet prosecutor. She is his present wife, today she is around 56-60 years old.

During the war RAKOSI became ~~the~~ one of the directors of the Kossuth Radio at Moscow. He made speeches to the Hungarian people several time^s weekly. Again an uncontrolled information says that at this time he had a great fight with his rival SZABADOS Michael(christian name uncertain). During the war, news circulated in Hungary named SZABADOS as the leader of the Hungarian communists. RAKOSI in order to get rid of his rival SZABADOS, had him framed through GERO Erno and became the leader of the Hungarian emigration at that time in Russia. A few times RAKOSI visited ^{camps of} prisoner^s of war ~~camps~~ in Russia but did not make a pleasant impression on the Hungarian prisoners. (His appearance and figure).

As it is known, RAKOSI played an important role also in the KOMINTERN

In the first months Rakosi had no public role and moved around all over as a leader of the party. However even at this time he was the unrestricted master completely.

In 1945 only GERO Erno remained close to RAKOSI, all the other true followers were compromised; REVAI Joseph, FARKAS Michael, VASS Zoltan, etc. RAKOSI reached the stage that he had arrested the head of the secretariat DONATH Francis, who ~~was~~ was released from jail just recently.

In April 1945 RAKOSI moved from Debrecen to Budapest and had an apartment in the ~~Szabo~~ Szabo Jozsef street, XIV district, close to the Millenary soccer stadium. At present he lives on the Szabadsag hill, Budapest, He moves around in a car, runs up to the Istenhegy road to the Orban square, turns right, but from there can not be observed because there is a police sentry turning away pedestrians. On the other side of the Szabadsag hill the road is blocked the same way.

When RAKOSI is traveling, three cars move along, no one knows which car he is occupying. 6-8 AVH ~~averting~~ ^{averting} officers are constantly traveling with him.

One by one RAKOSI called the writers to himself. Previously he demanded information about them. When NEMETH Ladislas called on him, RAKOSI told Nemeth, what Nemeth made (earned) last year, what he is working on now, what are his problems, etc. For instance during his conversation with Nemeth, RAKOSI pulled out a file from his desk and started to read what Nemeth earned for this and that of his works. Another example; he summoned MAJOR Otto who is a younger writer, and received him with the words " Comrade Major you have nothing to fear for your anti-Tito theater piece. Man makes mistakes but

should dare to exercise selfcriticism. You should apply this on the stgge." MAJOR who wrote an anti-Tito play, is now working on exactly the opposite trend piece. RAKOSI probably received his information regarding NEMET's problems from the AVH.

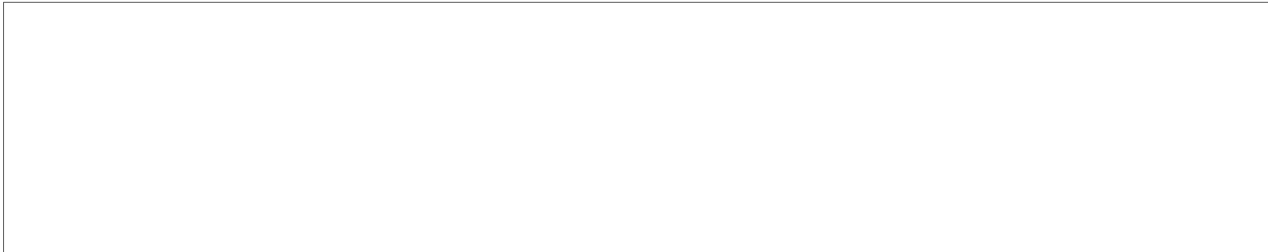
Once RAKOSI liked sports for the popularity values. However at one occasion the security men found a hand grenade close to RAKOSI's loge at the Dozsa soccer field in UJpest and since then he(RAKOSI) can be seen very seldom at sport events. When he has to appear at the Peoples Stadium there are at least one hundred security ~~ppp~~ agents to guard him - the vicinity off his loge is evacuated, only confident, reliable people are tolerated there in the L sector, and even the ushers, ticket-takers are AVH men.

If he goes to the theater, the scene and setup is about the same. More interesting plays are presented at protocole performances, meaning that only guests invited by the AVH ✓ can be present. Great precaution is taken here also. At first he took his vacations at Balatonkartya but newly he has a ^{separate} cottage at Balatonoszod. His mountain retreat is in the Matra hills about 550 yards from the Gallyateto great Hotel.

Objectively skeaking, it has to be acknowledged that RAKOSI Matyas is very educated and well read man. Among the emerged personalities in the Hungarian political life since 1945 RAKOSI takes a promin~~nt~~ place by his intelligence. He planned the political strategy of the communist party. However he is a bad judge of character. Until now he had to be disappointed in every man of his selection.


RAKOSI is in closer friendship—among the Hungarian politicians— with HAZI Arpad. R. is the godfather, and his wife the godmother of the HAZI children. From political considerations way back in 1946 he did not proclaim his struggle against the Church and his wife held the HAZI children for baptism. At that time the "Képes Figyelo" magazine published pictures of the occasion.

His human weakness, that after his rise to power through the Soviet armies he had arrested every prison guard who mistreated him during his jail time at the Vac jail and at the Szeged Csillag prison. Several of them were liquidated and other sent to jail. Objectively it has to be stated that among the communist politicians he is the most educated. With some exaggeration it could be said that he with his intellectual capacity ~~is~~ emerges from the Hungarian politicians of the last ten years. However here it has to be added that his politics ^{always} was built up on the bayonets of the Soviet army. It is natural that he speaks the Russian language almost perfectly. It could be said in his favor that he forced his wife to learn Hungarian and in public places talks to her in Hungarian. This same cannot be said about other leading personalities who communicate with their Russian wives in Russian.

At present, RAKOSI's biggest problem is the clearing up of the Tito matter.

[redacted] Hungarians led the anti-Tito campaign, among the satellite nation. In this RAKOSI took the palm. He used first the expression of "chained dog". Now he would like to put all the blame on PETER Gabor and his gang. At the same time his speeches and writings do not prove this. At the reopening of the RAJK case, he stood on the forum before the people and claimed that he hesitated for days until his decision was made up. Later in 1927 he was involved in one of the cells that was discovered by the police. He spent a short term in prison and after that went to Moscow through Czechoslovakia.

According to unconfirmed information he took part in the organisation of the Czechoslovak young communist party around the 1930-es.

In Moscow he attended several party schools and party universities and he was from the beginning one of the main ideologists of the party even in Hungary.

Started his role at Szeged. He recruited into the Hungarian political life BALOGH Istvan Roman catholic priest of the Also Tanya central district of Szeged. REVAI was the leader of the propaganda work, the communist press and the first daily the "Debrecen Nép" started under his guidance.

After BERO, he REVAI too became a member of the National General Council. When the government moved to Budapest he became the ^{chief} editor of the central paper of the party the "Szabad Nép".

He is one of the planner and executor of the communist political tactics; the nationalisation of the banks, the nationalisation of the mines, and the fight against the Church, etc.

REVAI took as his share the intellectual field, education. As minister of public instruction his authority covered the book publishing, press, radio, theater, etc. He nationalized all the theaters in Hungary. He directed the book-burning when King Lear, David Copperfield and other works were declared to be reactionary.

From the beginning he was interested in the Free Masonry movement and considered this movement ~~as~~ from the view point of progressive communism as the greatest enemy of the party, even greater than the Church.

These five men of the Hungarian politics ; RAKOSI Matyas, GERO Erno, FARKAS Michael, REVAI Joseph and VASS Zoltan are considered as the No.1. team of Moscow, after the times of 1945. For years all power was concentrated in their hands in every field.

RONAI, Sandor, president of the parliament(assembly).

RONAI is an old man of the workers movement. Original trade bricklayer(mason). He was secretary of the social democratic party at Miskolc even before 1945. At this time the workers of the vicinity and the left side elements acknowledged Ronai as an authority (in labor matters) because he bravely struggled against the Horthy system's authorities. He remained in this position even after 1945. His situation changed only in that respect that he became member of the parliament on the social democratic ticket. Since then he is uninterruptedly a member of the legislation. At the end of 1945 or at the beginning of 1946 when the social-democratic party received the ministry (the portfolio) of public alimentation RONAI Sandor received this position. RONAI did not do anything at all here (in this job) his every move showed that he does not understand it. Unfortunately he selected his collaborators badly. They implanted in him the seed of vanity and since then he is looking for appearance in public and is chasing popularity. From the top of the ministry of public alimentation the former bricklayer was put in charge of the ministry of commerce, Around this time he was already the member of the highest management of the social-democratic party. While he was minister, the socialization of commerce started. He proclaimed the crusade against commerce. As minister of commerce he pledged himself to the communists. He has been the penetrated man of the communist party in the social-democratic party and he has a great share that the social-democratic party could be dissolved into the communist party. He informed GERO and REVAI exactly of the intentions of the social-democratic leaders. When the fusion of the two so-called labor parties has been effected, (the social-democratic and the communist parties) RONAI as a former social-democrat also became a member of the political committee of the New Party of the Hungarian Workers. However, this "King for a day" farce lasted only a few months.

Later, when on Soviet pattern the Presidium Council was created RONAI became the president of the Presidium Council. He had no independent voice or action. At this time his old collabodators were taken away from him and he was surrounded with "reliable" communists. When again from political tactical reasons a peasant origin president became necessary they simply had RONAI resigned and put ^{him} in charge as president of the parliament. He fills this post up today.

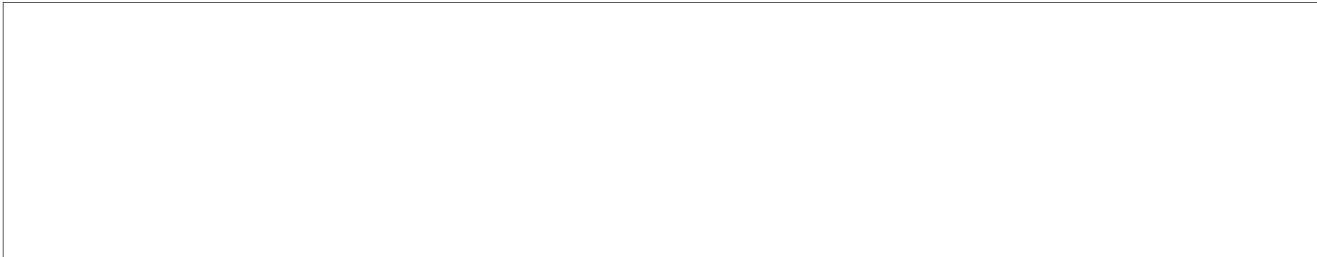

SANDOR, Laszlo, section head of the central management of the DISZ.(Democratic Federation Youth Federation).



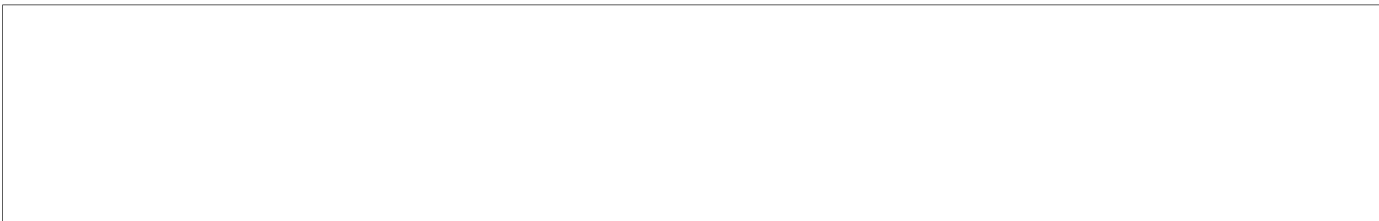

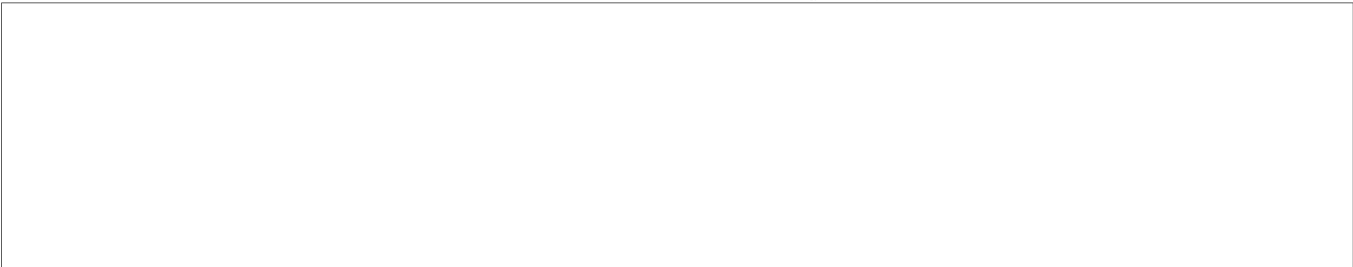

UJLAKI graduated from highschool at Debrecen.

After 1945, UJLAKI worked as newspaperman at the "Szabad Nep" the central party paper. First, he edited the Court column, but later switched over to the political line. In 1947 already he studied a one year party course, and then was sent to Moscow where he also studied for a year. This has been an upper level agitation propaganda school. When he has returned home, he became the director of the home politics column of the MTI (Magyar Tavirati Iroda-Hungarian News Agency) and then from here was transferred to the press department of the prime ministry. In 1953 when NAGY Imre has been the president of the council of ministers UJLAKI ~~is~~ was already the head of the press-information section of the prime ministry. This post he filled until March 1955, when he was transferred to the editorial offices of the "Szabad Nep" as reader-editor. Today he really is one of the directors of the party paper.

He is a member of the Party of Hungarian Workers since 1945. The uppermost layer of the communist leaders, beginning from RAKOSI, all know UJLAKI and have trust in him. In the last years he always received more and more difficult tasks to solve.

We do know each other with UJLAKI since we were 5-6 years old, and therefore we dare to talk to each other frankly. Here I have to mention yet, that in the meantime for a while UJLAKI has been the head of the personnel section of the peoples education ministry, that handled placements and supervision of newspapermen and writers.

VARGA graduated from the Red Academy at Budapest. After graduation he became very soon deputy minister of the interior. At the ministry he has not handled police matters, but the direction and supervision of village and city administration.

He has been the leader of that delegation which studied the work of the councils (soviets) in the Soviet Union and in Rumania. He and his immediate collaborators prepared in Hungarian connection the Council-Law. Therefore his name is connected with the fact that the old village and city administration has been dissolved in Hungary and instead councils(~~soviets~~) local soviets) were formed.

From the ministry of interior he was transferred to the Secretariat of the Council of Ministers, and there the highest direction of the council matters belongs to him. There were times when the work of the councils were completely directed by the presidency of the council of ministers and not by the ministry of interior. At the present this function is divided (between the mentioned two organs) but

even today still the highest organ is the council-secretariat functioning next to the council of ministers. The head of this secretariat is still VARGA.

VASS, Zoltan. Real name Weinberger Zoltan, unbelievable great passion for life. He laid the foundation of his carrier when returned from Moscow and was jailed ~~to the~~ together with RAKOSI. Of his experiences in prison he wrote a book, published among the first books in Hungary in 1945. A few years ago new edition was published.

It is common talk that during the 15 years prison term Vass behaved more and humanly courageously than even RAKOSI.

He is on the political stage of Hungary since the fall of 1944. His name became known first when he saved the people of Budapest from hunger in 1945 as government comisar for public alimентация. Later became mayor of Budapest. In this latter position he was already a willing servant of the communist ideology.

VASS was (next to GERO) the economic political executive of the party. He participated in this work with unbelievable energy. He takes great share for the credit that Hungarian economic life took such an upturn in the years of 1945-46-47. One could always talk to him about business. He adopted and supported good ideas. He had a great share in the liquidation of the 1946 inflation. At this time he formed the later infamous West-Orient company. These companies traded in smuggling with government control.

VASS tried to help and support the former owners of confiscated factories - -whom GERO most readily would have executed - VASS left some of them at their

own factories as managers, and some he transferred to other jobs. At this time he was general secretary of the Economic High Council and later became the president of the Government Planning Office. As president of the High Economic Council the economic ministries belonged under his supervision. Through him the Soviets controlled and supervised the Hungarian economic life.

VASS remained as economic political executive. The planning office grew and grew and this aroused the jealousy of GERO Erno more and more. In the meantime VASS subordinated the Country Invention Office, the Modernisation Office and the Measure and Standards Office. The Modernization Office was the most important because he could show toward the Soviet Union that the popularisation of Soviet working methods is also under his care. In 1951 the Planning Office had more employees than any ministry and in the Nadár street houses were requisitioned for the Planning Office one after the other.

The great clash occurred in 1952 between VASS and GERO. VASS as president of the Planning Office has not agreed with the great construction and development

§ of Sztalinvaros, Kazincbarcika and KOMlo. He even had the courage to raise his voice against the construction of the Budapest subway. At this time he occupied a very respectable position in the management of the party. The bitter clash and fight of the two economic experts of the party was observed with breath withheld by the intimates. GERO to neutralize the Planning Office created a certain economic top office

However this office did not last long because VASS had it liquidated on the pretext that this office only served the bureaucracy. By 1952 the glass was filled to the brim ~~and~~ and GERO seemingly lost the battle. However at this time VARGA Jenő arrived from Moscow, and he took GERO's side and the economic struggle ended with the victory of GERO.

The difference between the two ~~economic~~ party leaders consisted in their economic ideas and view points. GERO wanted to solve every problem in the Soviet methods and in Soviet time schedule. He said " If the economic transition to the road of socialism can be executed only by sacrificing 100.000 families then they must be liquidated because rather should 100.000 perish for four million than vice versa".

Against this, VASS believed that the Hungarian industry should be led toward socialism by keeping its own characteristics. Namely we should not neglect our agricultural and light industries and should support the heavy industry only according to our forces and raw material supply. This was his biggest sin. GERO told him plainly; "Comrade VASS does not need Sztalinvaros, he does not want Kazincbarcika because there the future is shaped and built and not the present comfortable life."

VASS supported secretly and helped many of the former owners of the socialized factories and shops. A characteristic example; VASS employed old man KALLOS the former

owner of the Schmoll and Kallos large shoe polish company, as chemical expert to the Country Invention Office. Gero charged VASS for this also. Finally VARGA Jenó pronounced the inalterable decision. The economic policy of VASS Zoltan does not follow the classic Marxist-Leninist line. RAKOSI was only an observer of this fight but did not interfere from political reasons, RAKOSI was not certain that the fight is not fought also against him.

VASS had to leave his leading position of the Hungarian economic life. No outward communication was given to the people. The communications said that the mining industry is struggling with difficulties and the greatest trouble is at Komlo and therefore the dynamic VASS Zoltan will be transferred there to create order. At the KEB (Central Inspection Committee) GERO accused VASS with economic sabotage and demanded court action. This could not be tolerated by RAKOSI and he intervened. In spite of this it is a historical fact that on the order of GERO, VASS left the presidential position of the Planning Office and previously he was in house arrest for two three days. RAKOSI turned to Suslov who prohibited the execution of the GERO steps and intentions.

The KEB reprimanded VASS severely for the anti-party economic policy and his private life in every detail was aired there too. For weeks the AVH was busy to clear up all VASS's tender relations from 1945. Whole lists were prepared and his life was branded as immoral and he was transferred to Komlos as head of the Mining trust.

In effect the transfer of VASS was a step against RAKOSI because he protected and helped VASS.

VASS very soon made himself liked at Komlos and fought for the rights of the miners. It became proved that GERO was in the wrong for the economic political direction and led the country on the brink of bankruptcy. This was not confessed openly - not even in Nagy Imre's time - but GERO's influence became smaller

When the star of the NEP era came up VASS Zoltan was brought to the front again. However it is not uninteresting to know that before he was sent to Komlo, VASS and his ^{whole} circle of friends were observed and watched by the AVH. When he left Budapest, his secretary was taken to the AVH where they wanted to force her to make accusing incriminating confession against VASS. They did not succeed completely and she was deported. When VASS heard about this, he did everything to ease her situation and to have the deportation order but he failed in this. changed. At this time GERO already used VASS's wife in the manhunt against her husband . From Komlo VASS came to Budapest and first became manager of the economic matters at the Secretariat of the Council of Ministers and later became chief of the secretariat, and at this time his human traits came to the fore more and more. He married his secretary who previously was deported because of him. The party consented to his divorce with difficulty but finally he was granted the necessary permission. He is still married to his former secretary [redacted]
