Lehmann (fnu) and Stimper (fnu) of the VEB Funkwerk (radio equipment factory) Koepenick to Erfurt, Leipzig, and Karl-Marx-Stadt in July 1956 to investigate the requirements for remote-controlled mine signal installations in the mining areas near those cities. They contacted representatives of the FAB (Fernmelde-anlagenbau=telecommunications installations construction) Leipzig and Dresden and the Kali-Ing.-Buero (Potash Engineering Office) Erfurt. As a result of the trip, the two men from Koepenick reported that approximately 25 installations could be scheduled for production, to be distributed as follows: 5 for the FAB Leipzig; 5 for the Kali-Ing.-Buero Erfurt; 10 for the SDAG Wismut; and 5 for export. They also reported that equipment would be needed at Wismut for new Schaechte (pits) envisaged in the district of Ronneberg. No actual customers were named for the five installations allocated for export.
