36-1 Road from Gilgit to Chalt, Pakistan, just north of Normal. Road was blocked by a rock slide. A higher road, which can be seen, was used as a detour. <i>CIA 211263</i>		
24-1 Same road at a point a little nearer Chalt.		
22-1 Same road - eight miles north of Gilgit. <i>211271</i>		
21-1 Same road five miles north of Gilgit. <i>CIA 211272</i>		
20-1 Same road four miles north of Gilgit - width can be judged from the jeep tracks. <i>CIA 211269</i>		
18-1 Second from right - with long sleeves - is General Kiani, Commanding General and Political Affairs Officer of Gilgit territory.		
8-1 Taken from two miles north of Rawalpindi, toward Muree. Rawalpindi in the background. <i>CIA 211261</i>		
19-2 Road Gilgit - Chalt, near Gilgit, looking south. <i>CIA 211270</i>		
12-2 Gilgit - an aqueduct can be seen along the mountain. Note vegetation below the viaduct. A fertile area producing fruits, nuts, corn, and vegetables. <i>CIA 211266</i>		
11-2 Hunza River looking north. In lower foreground is Chalt. At upper left, a line of trees marks the road and aqueduct. Beyond the spur is Mt Rakaposhi and town of Tol. <i>CIA 211265</i>		
8-2 Soy bean patch in Tol.		
7-2 Hunza children in Tol. The man in the blue shirt is a lawyer who acts as interpreter for General Kiani. Name forgotten.		
6-2 Mt Rakaposhi, taken from Tol. Submitted only as the best piece of photography I have encountered. <i>CIA 211268</i>

- 3-3 Road leading due west from Gilgit to high Summer grazing area. Road will not handle any motor traffic. Stream's name forgotten but is full of trout. *CIA 211267*
