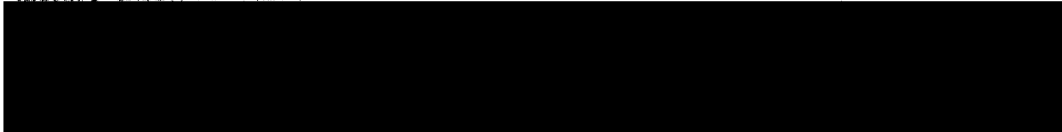

- 2. The purpose of the study is to:

- (a) Obtain an insight into the importance of skills and know-how as a limiting factor to livestock production, and

- (b) To appraise livestock production in Egypt, with special emphasis on beef cattle production, and to evaluate the need for skills in the growing livestock economy of Egypt.

- 3. Chapter one describes the setting of the problem, gives the purpose and scope of the study, indicates the method of research and source of data, and the organization of the report.

- 4. Chapter two deals with a discussion and analysis of economic trends affecting the development of the livestock industry in Egypt. Basically it briefly describes some of the pertinent agricultural land and its population, analyzes the trends in agricultural production, and indicates the impact industrialization is having on agricultural production.

- 5. Chapters three and four discuss the economic position of the livestock industry in Tennessee and the South (USA) and some of the factors affecting its development. Also an analysis of the importance of skills as a limiting factor to beef cattle production in Fayette County, Tennessee.

- 6. Chapter five is related to Chapters two, three and four, in that it is an attempt to appraise the problem of lack of education and skills in the production of livestock on the part of producers in Egypt. It gives some possible recommendations as to what needs to be done to help improve the status of the livestock production
