1. In March 1953, [REDACTED] received an order for a Model III, 8 Channel Electro-encephalograph (EEG) from Dr Reisner in Vienna, Austria. Dr Reisner is listed as Director Dozent at the Nervenheilanstalt Der Stadt Wien Rosenhugel, Niedelgasse 5 Wien XIII. Because [REDACTED] does not ship an instrument of this type to unqualified persons, we asked [a well-known US doctor] if he could vouch for Dr Reisner and the hospital to which the instrument would be sent. The doctor sent us the following information in July 1953.

2. "When I was [REDACTED] I spent a morning with Dr Reisner who at that time was oberarzt in the Nervenklinik. He impressed me as a very well trained neurologist who also had a working knowledge of psychiatry. At the time I was there [1949], the clinic had a homemade EEG apparatus which seemed reasonably well constructed."
