1. Reference is made to your memorandum dated 27 March 1957 wherein a covert security approval was requested for the Subject to permit his use under Project INGLIS.

2. In accordance with the provisions set forth in Clandestine Service Instruction No. [redacted] and Field Regulation [redacted] a covert security approval is granted for the use of the Subject, as described in your request as set forth in paragraph 1, above.

4. Your attention is called to the fact that a covert security approval does not constitute complete compliance with the provisions of CIA Regulation [redacted]. Therefore, if you should desire at a later date to change the status or use of this individual, a request for approval to cover any proposed change should be submitted to this office.

5. This approval becomes invalid in the event the Subject's services are not utilized within 60 days of the date of this memorandum.

1. Reference is made to your request for comment and assistance in resolving the problem of accounting for the receipt of subject funds by certain individuals and/or organizations in the preparation of income tax returns.
2. This office has established a very satisfactory liaison with the Treasury Department concerning matters of this nature and is fully aware of the various aspects of this situation. The establishment of a standard operating procedure would not be feasible due to the variety of amounts involved, employment status of the individual involved, and the possibilities of the organizations involved being tax exempt.
3. It is recommended therefore that these cases be referred to this office on an individual basis for review and appropriate recommendation.

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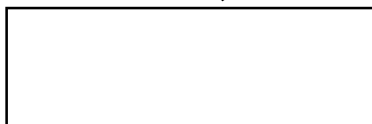
