
Shipment of Ergot of Rye or Phenol Crystals to Hungary. DAS #1507

Reference: State Despatch, Antwerp #109, dated 19 September 1951

- 1. Attached for your information is a thermoprint of reference despatch which we discussed a short time ago and which you agreed to accept for action.
- 2. We request that, if possible, the material that was shipped be positively identified, i.e., was it actually ergot of rye, phenol crystals or some other substance.
- 3. If it is ascertained that the material shipped was ergot, the following information is requested:
 - a. Original British source of the material.
 - . b. Destination of the shipment in Hungary.
 - c. Intended end use of the ergot in Hungary.
- 4. We would also appreciate being informed of any evidence of accelerated movement of ergot from Western Europe to Iron Curtain countries.
 - 5. In reply, please refer to DAS #1507.

2. Portuguese agents have canvassed Spain purchasing large amounts of ergot at very high prices for shipment behind the "Iron Curtain" through Portuguese ports.

mation, which is considered true, plus reports from various other dources of numerous large and small purchases of ergot and its derivatives by the Satellites throughout the world, confirm the notable interest of the Soviet Bloc in these substances. From ergot, a fungus disease of rye, other cereals, and wild grasses, there is obtained a valuable drug used for controlling hemorfhage, for uterine contraction, and for numerous other important medical purposes.

It is pointed out, however, that ergot is also an effective mental confusion agent and has been considered, therefore, as a possible CW material. The above reports strengthen the probability that the Soviets are processing ergot for military as well as medicinal purposes.
