(Newspaper Extract--Alleged Agency
Infiltration of the Overseas Education
Fund of the League of Women Voters)

1. Reference is made to the attached extracts (allegations 371.99914 and 333.993) from The American Woman dated 15 February 1975 and the University of Washington Daily (Seattle), in substance containing the allegation by one Ann Roberts that the Agency has infiltrated the Overseas Education Fund of the League of Women Voters.

2. Office of Security indices are negative in the names of the Overseas Education Fund and the Overseas Education Fund of the League of Women Voters. Ann Roberts cannot be identified from the information provided.

3. Office of Security file number 341308 concerns the League of Women Voters; however, there is no information in this file suggesting Agency infiltration of the League of Women Voters or the Overseas Education Fund thereof. For the most part, the file consists of newspaper clippings and cross-reference cards. The notable exceptions are as follows:
