SUBJECT: Scientific and Technical Intelligence Support  
for Developers of Tactics and Doctrine

1. A recently completed study has demonstrated that scientific and technical intelligence (S&TI) support to the research and development (R&D) community can be improved by taking a more systematic approach to the interface between the S&TI and R&D communities. Two of the key concepts are: (a) to improve responsiveness by bringing the user into both the requirements and evaluation processes, and; (b) to coordinate the S&TI production program with the supported R&D program. In general, this can be done without the reallocation of resources.

2. It also appears that the system which has been devised for S&TI support to developers of weapons could be adapted to serve the developers of military doctrine and tactics. To verify this and to discuss specific techniques, especially program documentation and correlation, I would like to have members of my study team confer with members of the Naval Field Operational Intelligence Office (NFOIO) on the afternoon of 31 August 1978. The meeting should not exceed three hours.
