1. I wish to respond informally to an item that you mentioned during the 24 February NIO meeting with the DCI. You mentioned DIA's objection to the tone of certain CIA articles appearing in the NIB (in regard to Chinese efforts to bolster their armed forces). The context in which the issue was raised suggested that the CIA management of the NIB had failed to coordinate properly.

(DIA felt hurt)

2. We became curious because we "monitor" the NIB as a Community enterprise and serve as an arbiter when there is trouble. After looking into the matter, we concluded that the issue arose primarily because of coordination problems within DIA. (Partly, it was the old DI-DE problem)

3. Anyhow, I thought you would want to know.
