Haiq Breakfast Item: DDI Rotations

1. As you know, one of my principal objectives is to increase significantly the number of senior managers in the DDI who have experience and familiarity with policy agencies and how the policy process works. To achieve this goal, I would very much like to send one or two first-rate GS-15s to serve a one-year rotation at the Department of State. I am prepared to provide people with whatever regional or functional background would be of greatest use to the Department, and I am prepared to provide them on a non-reimbursable basis (i.e., free). Here, too, I would willow a recipiosal wire
