



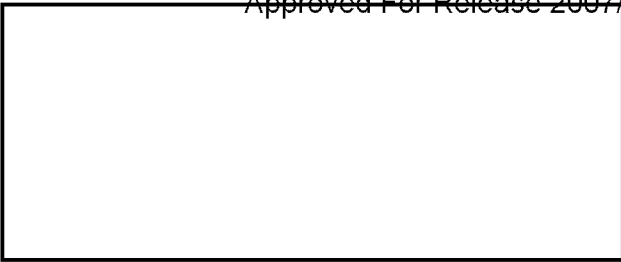

Dear Mr. Casey:

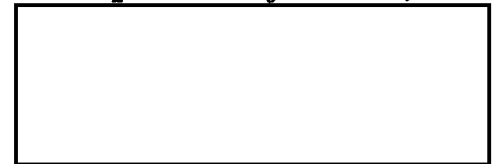
Recently, considerable controversy has arisen in our city concerning the value of foreign language education in the public schools.
