SUBJECT : Senator Percy's Questions about Sanctions

As a follow-on to our conversations, I have had revised talking points prepared for your discussions with Senator Percy (Att 1). Those talking points can be used verbatim if you desire. My staff has also pulled together the raw intelligence information (Att 2) which supports some of the judgments made in the talking points; it has not been possible to do this in all cases since some of the judgments are analytical and not derived from single documents. That raw intelligence is for you and your staff only; it can be alluded to orally in discussions with Senator Percy but, in keeping with long-standing procedures established to protect our sources and methods, should not be made available to him. If there is any other assistance I can provide on this matter, please let me know.
