1. As John M. Clark requested, you are hosting a luncheon meeting with Brookings Institution in cooperation with Nova University in the Executive Dining Room, Headquarters Building, on Wednesday, 17 November. There will be approximately 30-35 participants who have earned their doctorates in business and public administration; they are employed in public service careers at the federal, state, or local levels or in business, education and criminal justice functions.
