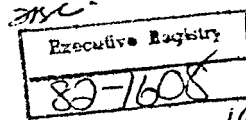

I am writing to invite you to a reception I am hosting with several other Senators for Gene Knorr, the Republican candidate for the U.S. Senate from North Dakota.


