**HOLY LAND STATE THE ONLY SOLUTION**  
**FOR PERMANENT PEACE IN MIDDLE EAST**

HOW LONG CAN WE DECEIVE  
 GOD AND HUMANITY  
 AND SURVIVE?

I. How long can we demand that Palestine be a Jewish state when the majority of Jews do not want to go there and thousands who emigrated there have already left or wish to leave?

II. How long can we maintain that Israel is a democracy when for 25 years it has remained a police state without a written constitution?

III. How long can we attack Communism and Soviet Russia while supporting an orthodox Marxist state of kibbutzim and Histadruth?

IV. How long can we cry out and proclaim as non-kosher German and gentile atrocities while declaring as kosher and applauding those of Israel against Semite Arabs?

V. How long can we dream of a permanent existence for a state called Israel when Israel cannot survive a single lost battle and the Arabs can sustain thousands?

VI. How long can we demand from Humanity sympathy and support for a "homeland" we abandoned 2,000 years ago and in the same breath ask civilized men to reject the pleas of recently routed Palestinians?

VII. How long can we continue to deceive the Western world that Israel is the only bastion of anti-Communism in the Middle East when in reality Communist Chechoslovakian arms helped establish the State and Russia voted for the partition of Palestine and was one of the first to recognize the state.

VIII. How long can we lure innocent and sentimental Jews with slogans of security and a full Jewish life into the great atheistic unsecured ghetto called Israel, where, in truth, every principle of Judaism is violated?

IX. How can we claim Zionism "solved the Jewish refugee problem by relocation in Israel when, in fact, it is the refugees who rejected Zionist temptations that now live in security and prosperity and support their impoverished relatives trapped in Israel?"

X. How can we delude ourselves that Israel can continue to exist without permanent peace and accommodation with the Palestinian Arabs? Only by sacrificing exclusive labels like "Israel" and "Palestine" and drawing together in a free, non-sectarian "Holy Land State" can both these peoples find life, liberty and happiness.

A group of American Jews and Israelis in New York, disturbed by the dangerous situation in the Middle East and concerned for the future of their co-religionists in Israel, met today to establish an organization to support the creation of a new Holy Land State in the Middle East. Adopting the name of Committee for a Holy Land State, they resolved to ask all Jews, Moslems and Christians of good will throughout the world to join with them to help in an effort to bring peace and safety to the troubled Middle East.

Mr. Haviv Schieber, an Israeli who was elected Chairman of the Committee for a Holy Land State, said: "Only by uniting Jews, Christians, and Moslems in a Spiritual Switzerland in the Middle East can permanent peace and prosperity be brought to the Middle East. We desire the participation and moral support of men of good will everywhere, and will make every effort to encourage the establishment of organizations to further the concept of a Holy Land State throughout the world, including in Israel and each of the Arab countries."

The new Committee for a Holy Land State will hold a meeting at the Church Center for the United Nations, 777 United Nations Plaza, New York City, at 8 o'clock p.m. on Friday, May 31st, at which Israeli and Arab speakers will address Arabs, Jews and others interested in seeking permanent peace with justice in the Holy Land.

*Draft for Comment and Suggestion*

This proposal has evolved from a basic concept put forward by Jews, Moslems and Christians of good will who are disturbed by the suffering and death of their co-religionists in the Holy Land.

Certain common tenets we hold to be undeniable:

- a) irrespective of form of worship, we each acknowledge and revere one Supreme Being;
- b) the roots and traditions of each of our faiths lie in an area we all call "The Holy Land" at the eastern end of the Mediterranean;
- c) although worshipping in diverse forms, our allegiance to the same, and sole, God renders us, if not brothers, at least cousins;
- d) in the light of this kinship the selfish, cruel and callous indignities we have, in the course of history, repeatedly inflicted upon one another can only be hypocrisy and blasphemy in the eyes of our Creator.

After 20 centuries of inhumanity towards one another, have we not grown to the spiritual and moral maturity to cease squabbling over our Religious Homeland, to put aside each group's egomania for exclusivity and bring peace and dignity, through sharing, to that land where God chose to reveal his teachings?

- Therefore, we entreat that:
- a) Christians set aside their Crusade psychology longing for re-constitution of the Kingdom of Jerusalem;
  - b) Jews forego the political-geographical recreation of a Biblical Israel;
  - c) Moslems resign their desire to re-establish the land of the Philistines (Palestine).

that all three join together in building to the Glory of God — a true Holy Land State.

**PROPOSAL DETAILS FOR A HOLY LAND STATE**

**Territory:** The Holy Land State shall encompass the area of the Palestine mandate.

**Territorial Integrity:** The Holy Land State shall be guaranteed by international compact with any small peace-keeping police force to be interfaith in character. There shall be no national military establishment.

**Constitution:** There shall be a written constitution adopted by the people of the Holy Land State. (In preparation of this, due consideration should be given to the example of such nations as Lebanon and Switzerland in achieving a balance of rights and powers among different groups.)

Included should be: *Freedom of Religion, Speech, Press, Opportunity.*

**Citizenship:** Guarantee of universal citizenship including provision that:

- a) Any person who holds or has held Israeli citizenship shall be assured full rights in the Holy Land State.
- b) Any person from the encompassed area, previously dispossessed or deprived of citizenship, shall be returned to full and unconditional status.
- c) Future immigrants from any country and of any religious persuasion shall be freely admitted and all shall have to meet a single uniform standard to achieve full citizenship.

**Official Languages:** Arabic, Hebrew and any other as the legislature shall decide.

**Education:** There shall be universal and uniform secular educational opportunity. Religious education shall be the responsibility of each faith.

**Judiciary:** The Courts System shall be so constituted as to recognize the different legal traditions arising from the different religions.

**Police Functions:** Shall be carried out by an interfaith unit to insure equality of law enforcement.

**Legislative & Executive Composition:** A balanced, rotating assignment of executive positions shall be established to guarantee that Christian, Jewish and Moslem segments of the population all have a hand in national operations. A tripartite balance amongst the three faiths shall be maintained in apportionment of legislative seats.

**Property Rights, Resettlement, Restitution:**

- a) Those, who in the turmoil of the last 25 years have lost property and/or lands, shall be recompensed and returned to a satisfactory and productive life.
- b) However, in providing for the rights of injured parties of Part (a) (Immediately above) who, who has lived in property or labor on land once held by others, shall be made destitute in redressing the earlier inequities.

It is recognized that the Property Rights section will require a high order of statesmanship for successful implementation. We suggest that an International Commission be established to oversee adjudication of all claims, that an International Aid Organization be set up to provide both technical assistance and funding, that governments currently supplying military aid to various countries in confrontation in the area cease such aid and provide comparable monies to solve the resettlement problem and that the charities of the three faiths be directed to his same purpose.

Only the creation of a demilitarized Holy Land State in Israel-Palestine will bring peace to the Middle East and solve the free world's energy problems. ## Holy Land Must Be Remodded

 It becomes more obvious with the passage of each day that the only solution to bring peace to the Holy Land is the Holy Land State program.

Back in 1947-48, this concept of a holy land state was viewed by President Truman and most of his staff as the solution to peace. He feared, as did most leaders of other nations, that a Jewish state would only lead to perpetual war. After

33 years of conflict, their wars have been proven to be well founded. Once again, the concept of a Holy Land State emerges as the only solution for permanent peace in the Middle East.

Jews in Israel are faced with two alternatives: to leave the country, as many have done in recent years; or to integrate themselves with the Palestinians according to the Holy Land State program. The latter alternative would lead to peaceful cooperation with their neighboring Arab countries.

They, especially the Palestinians, must recognize that prolonged bloodshed will not help in achieving their aims. It could very easily trigger a global conflict which could be devastating to all Arabs and, indeed, to all mankind.

It is only the American supplied military weapons that keeps the bankrupt Israeli leadership in power, and it is because of this power that they will oppose the Holy Land State solution or, for that matter, any other solution.

peaceful solution; 2) the peoples of the Middle East, including most of the Jews, would rejoice at the prospect of removal to the daily threat of war from their lives.

Everyone would agree that the Holy Land State concept is a nice dream. What follows is the HLS program to make that dream a reality.

This program is on two levels: the Holy Land Party in Israel and the Holy Land State Committees in the United States.

#### The Holy Land Party (Israel)

Negotiations have been underway for six months, and we are now at the stage of forming a Holy Land Party in Israel. We now have a nucleus of trusted members who will organize the Party, seek to register with the government and be recognized as a legitimate political party, and to run a slate

of candidates in the next election. If the party is registered, the HLP will organize, politicize, and campaign to build a coalition of Jews and Arabs.

Alternatively, if the Party is refused registration, the Party will be organized outside the occupied territories. They will draw a constitution, elect officers, form a government in exile, and seek diplomatic recognition. Subsequently, they will seek to replace Israel in the United Nations, and carry on all legitimate governmental functions such as issuing passports, granting citizenship, and even printing money.

#### The Holy Land State Committee (U.S.A.)

The Holy Land State committee U.S.A., will support all the activities of the Holy Land Party.

More importantly, however, will be the organizing of a core of

concerned citizens to counter the Zionist lobby by: 1) forming Holy Land State Committees in all 50 states; 2) producing a newsletter to keep these concerned citizens informed; 3) keeping the spotlight of public attention on the agents of the Zionist lobby, those government officials, and members of the media whose first loyalty is to Israel even to the detriment of the U.S.; 4) to form a legal study group to determine the legal remedies available to question the tax exempt status of Zionist organizations, and to seek the application of the Foreign Agent Registration Act to Zionist activists; 5) devise and implement a fund-raising program which does not violate the Holy Land State Committee policy of refusing to accept or seek funds from foreign governments or their representatives.
