DCI/DDCI-Assigned Tasks

EURA provided a review of attitudes and performance of the Papandreu government at the request of the DCI.

NESA provided an Iran-Iraq war update for the DCI.

OGI provided additional analysis to the DCI on European alternatives to Soviet gas in response to a request from Under Secretary of State Buckley.

The IIM "The Technology Acquisition Efforts of the Soviet Intelligence Services" has been forwarded to C/NIC for final review prior to transmittal to the DCI.

SOVA responded to a letter Senator Symms of the Senate Foreign Relations Committee sent to the DCI. Detailed answers were provided for three questions on Soviet activity in Cuba.

Of Special Interest This Week

ALA prepared a written brief on the possibility of a new Mariel exodus for use by Assistant Secretary of State for Inter-American Affairs Enders.

ALA briefed the HPSCI on Guatemala and Mozambique.

EURA and ALA briefed six members of the SSCI on the Falkland Islands situation. They also briefed DDS&T top management to provide an overview which pointed up technical collection deficiencies.



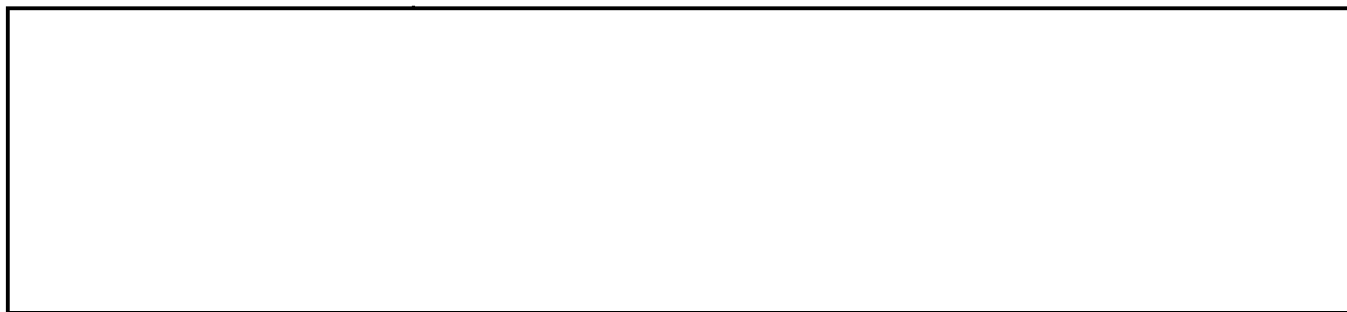

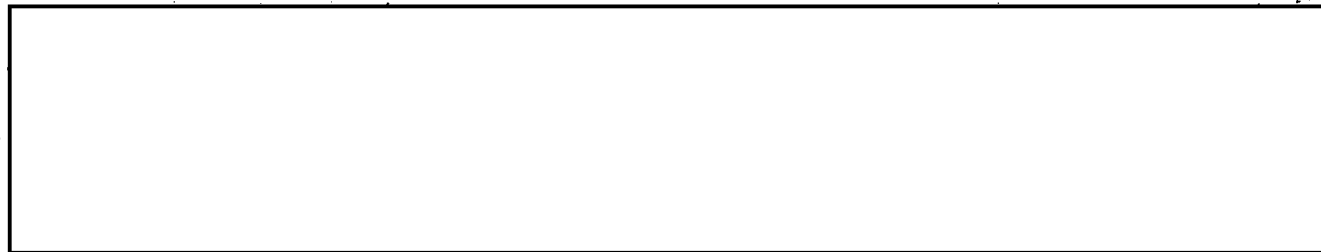
