Of Special Interest This Week

- o FBIS is distributing extensive materials on the public statements of Andropov. The Analysis Group distributed a collation of key Andropov statements directly to about a dozen Intelligence Community recipients, and produced a Special Memorandum entitled, "Andropov on Major International Issues: The Public Record." In addition, the Production Group and the Joint Publications Research Service are issuing a collection of major speeches and articles by Andropov including some unique material from a collection of untranslated Andropov speeches first published by the Soviets in 1979.
- o Beginning the evening of 10 November, when program changes on Moscow television and radio indicated a top-level Soviet official had died, the FBIS Wire Service was in touch by phone with major watch centers, including the White House Situation Room and State Operations. 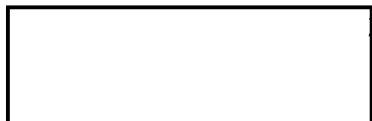
