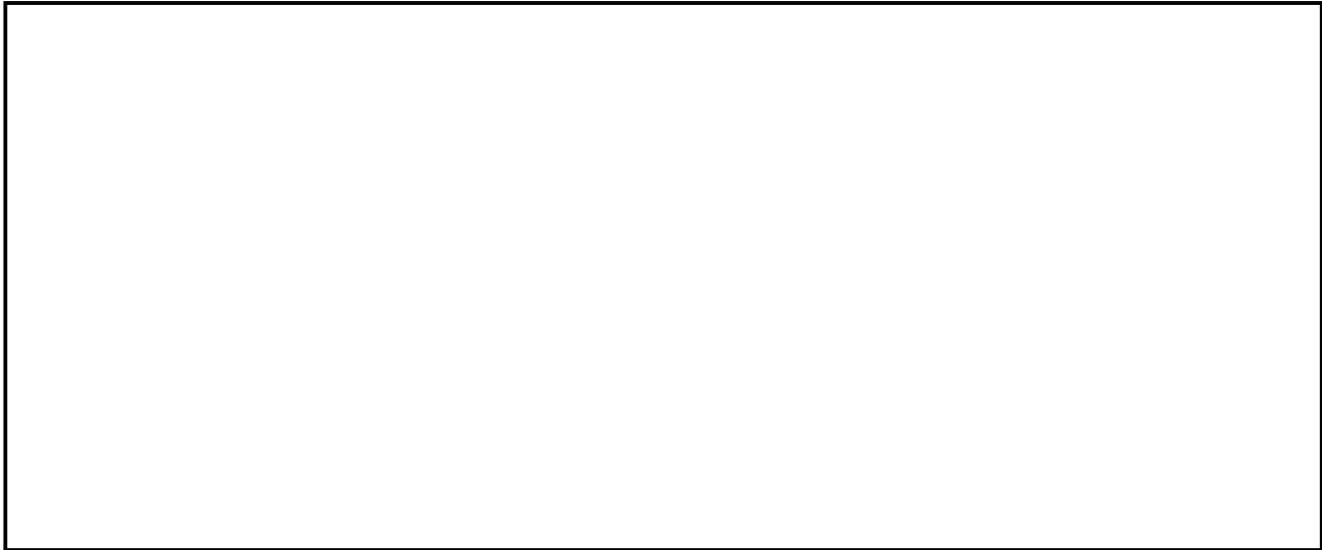

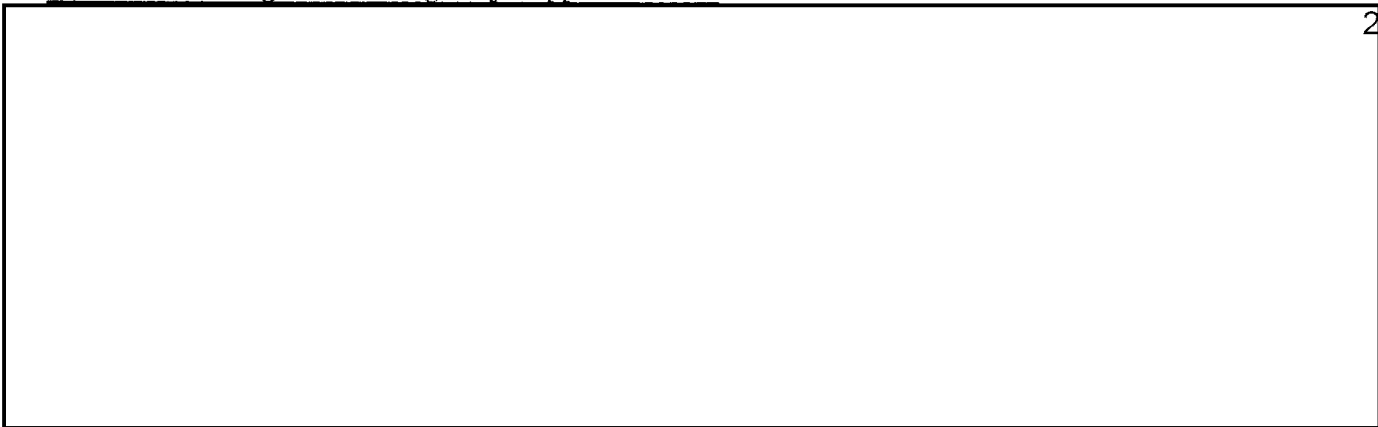

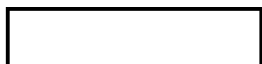

-- Legislative Liaison - Delivered copies of the SAFE reports to the HPSCI and SSCI.



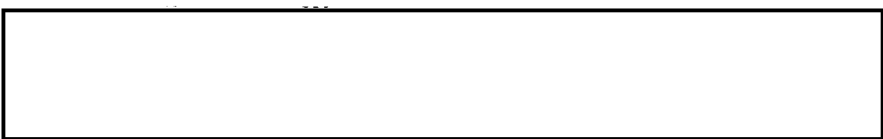
